

60 Minutes With God

(2 Timothy 3:16-17)

- Introduction:
1. Some time ago, I asked several people the question, "What would you ask God if you had the chance."
 2. I compiled several hundred answers to that question and plan to do a series of lessons on it eventually.
 3. But today, I wanted to pick out a few of the "most asked questions" from the list.
 4. As we go through this lesson, I want you to take notice of this fact: Many of the questions we would ask God, have already been answered by God.
 5. Those answers are right at our fingertips, in the Bible.

I. God, Where Did You Come From?

- A. (Psalm 90:2).
- B. (Psalm 93:2).
- C. The concept of "eternity" and an "eternal cause" is not just a "religious" view.

II. God, Why Did You Create Man?

- A. (Acts 17:24-25).
- B. (1 John 4:8).
- C. Why do humans have children?

III. God, How Do You Love The Sinner While Hating The Sin?

- A. (1 Timothy 1:13).
- B. Because they just don't fully comprehend.

IV. God, Is Jesus Coming Back In My Lifetime?

- A. (Matthew 24:36).
- B. Sometimes God's answers are simply, "Trust me."

V. God, Am I Saved?

- A. (Romans 8:16).
- B. The Holy Spirit and our spirit bear witness to the fact of whether we are saved or are not saved.

- Conclusion:
1. As we have examined some of these popular questions that we would ask God, I hope you took notice of this fact: The answers to the above questions were all contained in the Scriptures.
 2. In other words, we already had the answers to these questions.
 3. Therefore, let's show greater dedication to studying the word of God this year.
