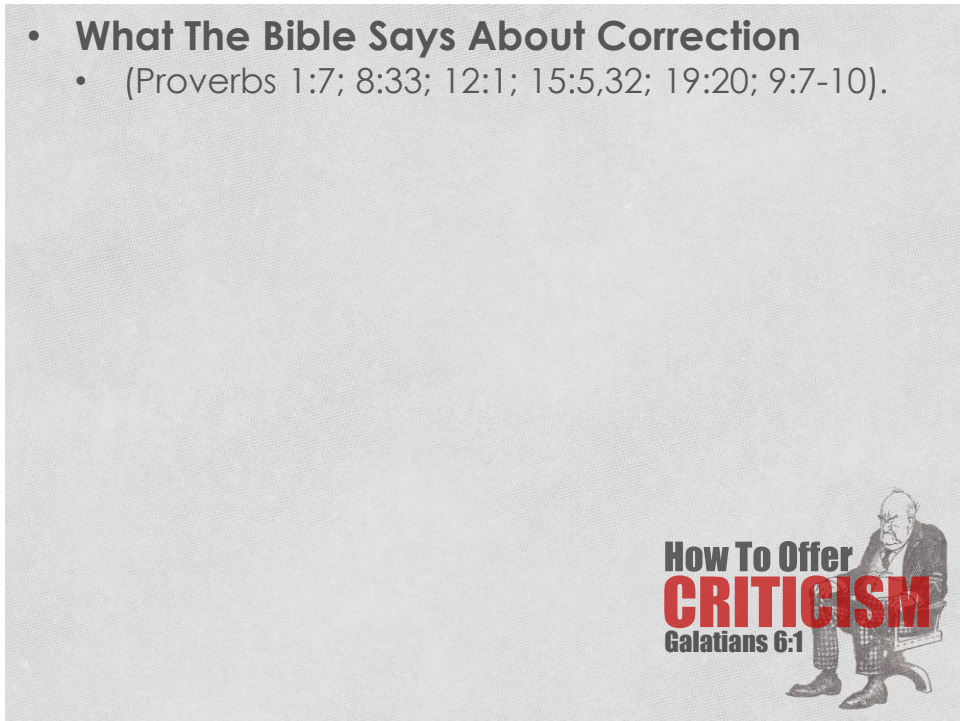


- **What The Bible Says About Correction**
 - (Proverbs 1:7; 8:33; 12:1; 15:5,32; 19:20; 9:7-10).

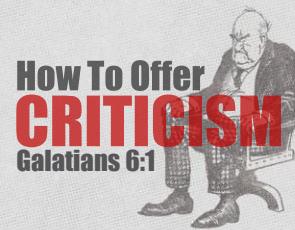


“The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction.”

(Proverbs 8:33)

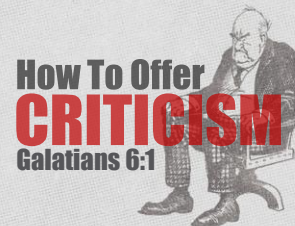


“Give instruction to a wise man, and he will be still wiser. Teach a just man, and he will increase in learning.”

(Proverbs 9:9)

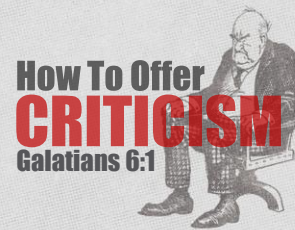
“Whoever loves instruction loves knowledge, but he who hates correction is stupid.”

(Proverbs 12:1)



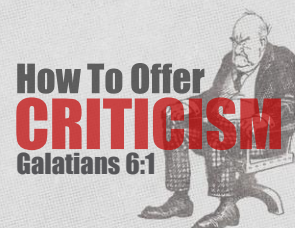
“A fool despises his father’s instruction,

(Proverbs 15:5,32)

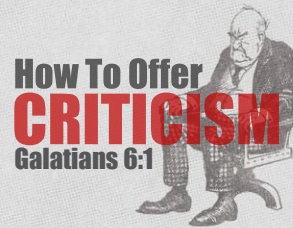


“Listen to counsel and receive
