

The Doctrine of Hell

- The Bible doctrine of Hell is under fire today.
- It is becoming an embarrassing artifact of ancient Christian faith.
- 2015 Pew Research Center
 - 58% believe in Hell.
 - 72% believe in Heaven.
- 2007 Barna Survey
 - 32% believed Hell was eternal, conscious punishment.



The Doctrine of Hell

- Views Concerning Hell
 - Simple Denial.
 - Conditionalists.
 - Annihilationists.
 - What they all have in common is the denial of everlasting, conscious, torment.



The Doctrine of Hell

- Objections to Hell
 - · A loving God would not do this.
 - (Rom. 11:22; Rev. 19:15).
 - It would not be fair.
 - Who are we to measure how bad sin is?
 - Hell is eternal in its consequence, not duration.
 - (Mt. 25:31-46).

The Doctrine of Hell

- What The Bible Says About Hell
 - Jesus taught about Hell.
 - It is the wrath of God (Heb. 10:29-31)
 - It is eternal (Mt. 25:46).

• It is described as fire (Rev. 20:15).

• There is no relief (Rev. 14:11).
