

# Some Things God Will & Will Not Do

(2 Peter 3:9)

- Introduction:
1. The existence of Hell is a reality (Matthew 5:22).
    - a. It is a place made for the devil and his angels (Matthew 25:41).
    - b. It is a place of torment (Revelation 14:11).
    - c. It is a place on no rest or relief (Revelation 14:11).
    - d. It is a place of weeping (Matthew 24:51).
    - e. It is eternal in its duration (Matthew 25:46).
  2. This reality causes some to question God's willingness to save all men.
  3. However, let us note some things God will and will not do to keep us out of Hell.

## I. Some Things God Will Not Do

- A. He will not take away our freedom of choice.
  1. (Matthew 7:13-14).
  2. (Revelation 22:17).
  3. Some simply choose not to obey (Acts 24:25; 26:28).
- B. He will not Save us in our sins.
  1. (John 8:21-24).
  2. (Numbers 14:18).
- C. He will not change his law because we don't obey it.
  1. (Galatians 1:6-9).
  2. (Psalm 119:89).
  3. (Matthew 24:36; John 12:48).

## II. Some Things God Will Do

- A. He will let His Son die for us.
  1. (John 3:16; 1:29).
  2. (Romans 5:8).
- B. He has given us the gospel.
  1. (Mark 16:15).
  2. (Romans 1:16).
- C. He continues to be good to us.
  1. (Romans 2:4).
  2. (James 1:17).
- D. He is patient with us.
  1. (2 Peter 2:9).
  2. (2 Peter 3:15).
- E. He loves us and is willing to receive us.
  1. (Luke 15:11-32).

- Conclusion:
1. God wants you to be saved. He desires your fellowship. He wants you to escape Hell.
  2. But the choice of Heaven or Hell is ultimately yours? What will you choose?
