



How Do We View Church?

- The problem many have with “church” is that they see it simply as an institution.
- They see religion as a set of rules.
- They see it as a museum rather than a living organism.
- Assimilation is not the same thing as discipleship.



Institution -vs- Relationship

- It's not an "either or" proposition.
- "Institution" is not bad.
 - It doesn't have to be cold and uncaring.
- Religion is not bad (James 1:27).
 - It doesn't have to just be rules.
- But in order for religion to be good, it has to leave the building.
- Jesus is the goal, not church.
- Jesus is our Savior, not church.
