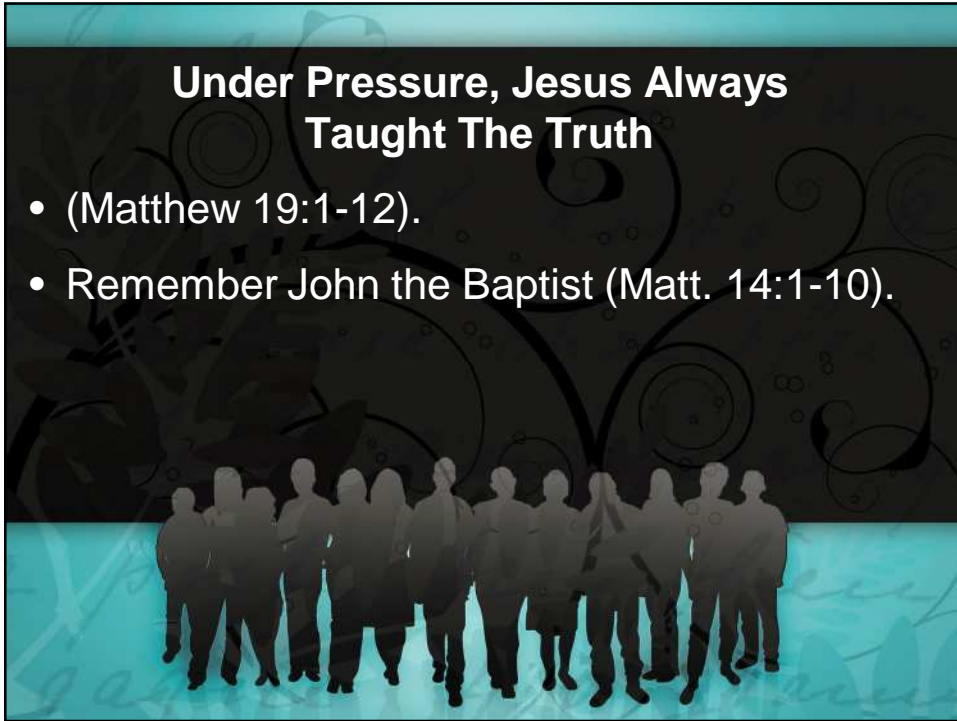


- Peer pressure is something that everyone faces, young and old.

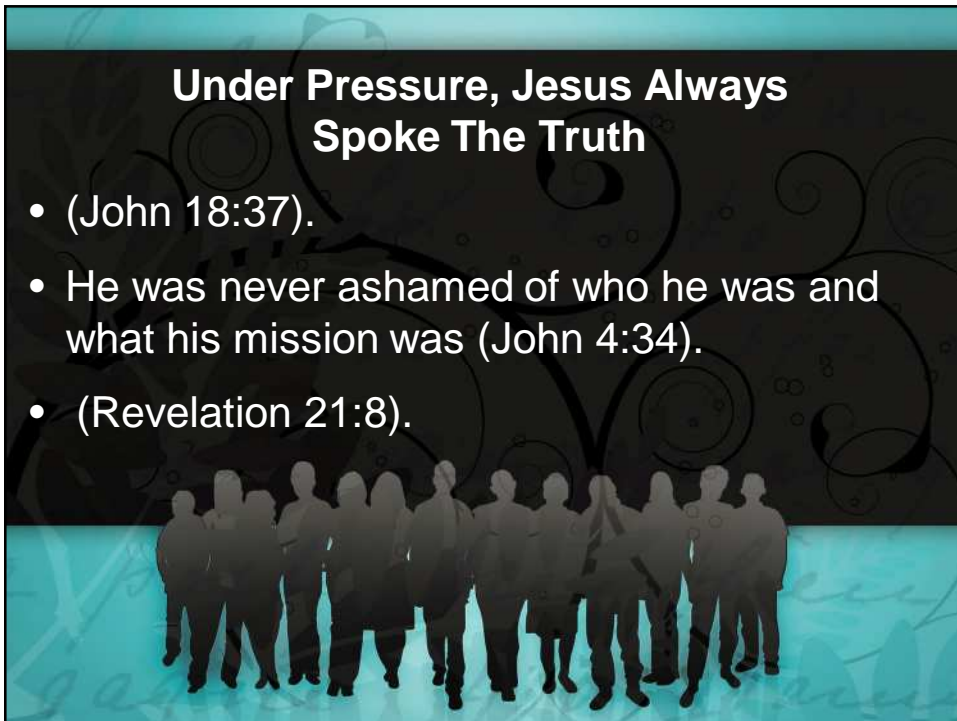
Under Pressure, Jesus Always Taught The Truth

- Remember John the Baptist (Matt. 14:1-10).



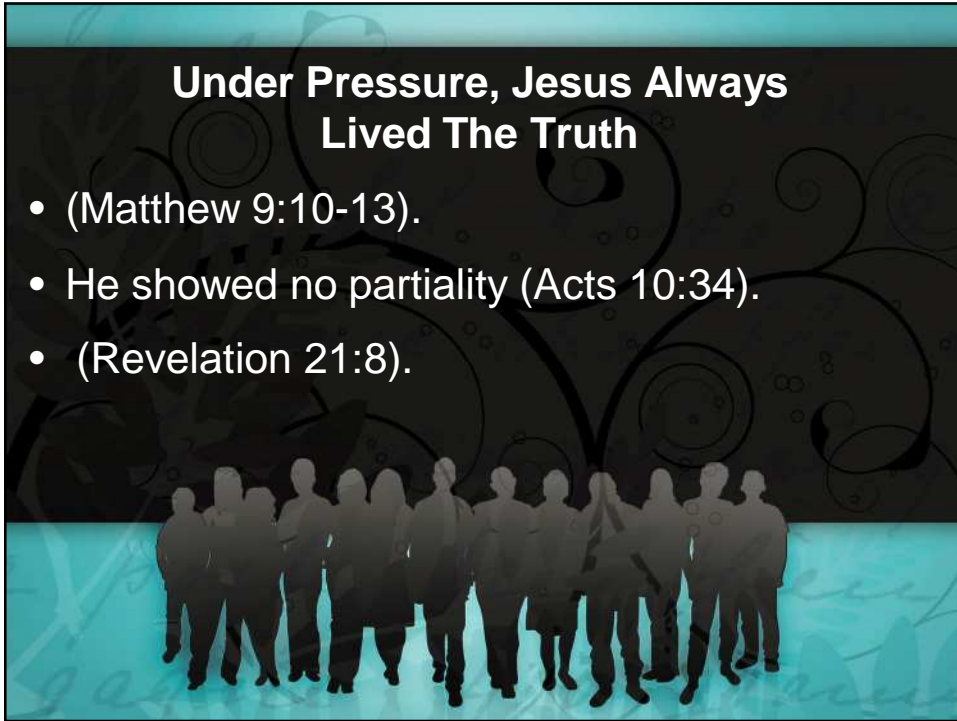
Under Pressure, Jesus Always Spoke The Truth

- He showed no partiality (Acts 10:34).
- (Revelation 21:8).
