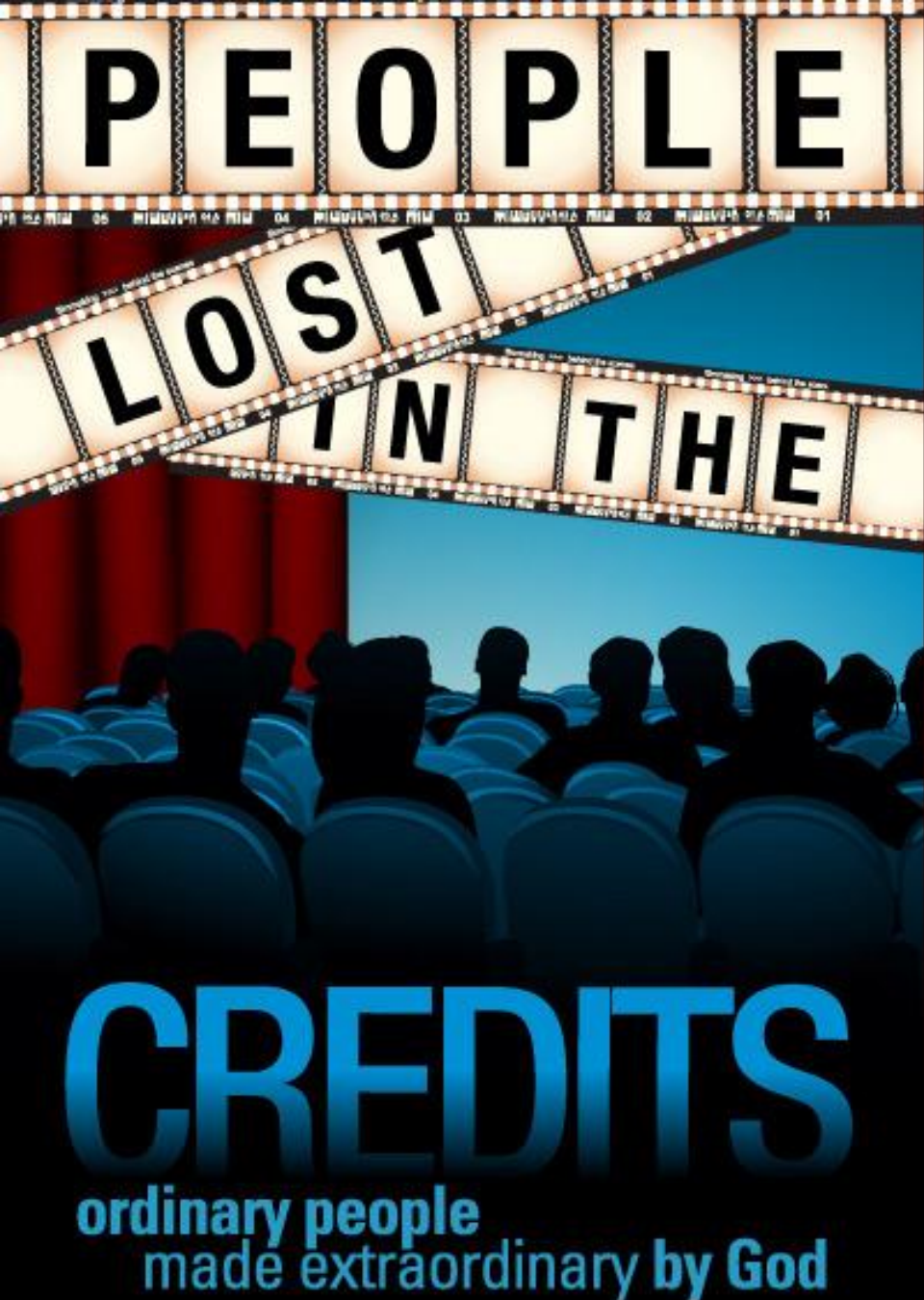

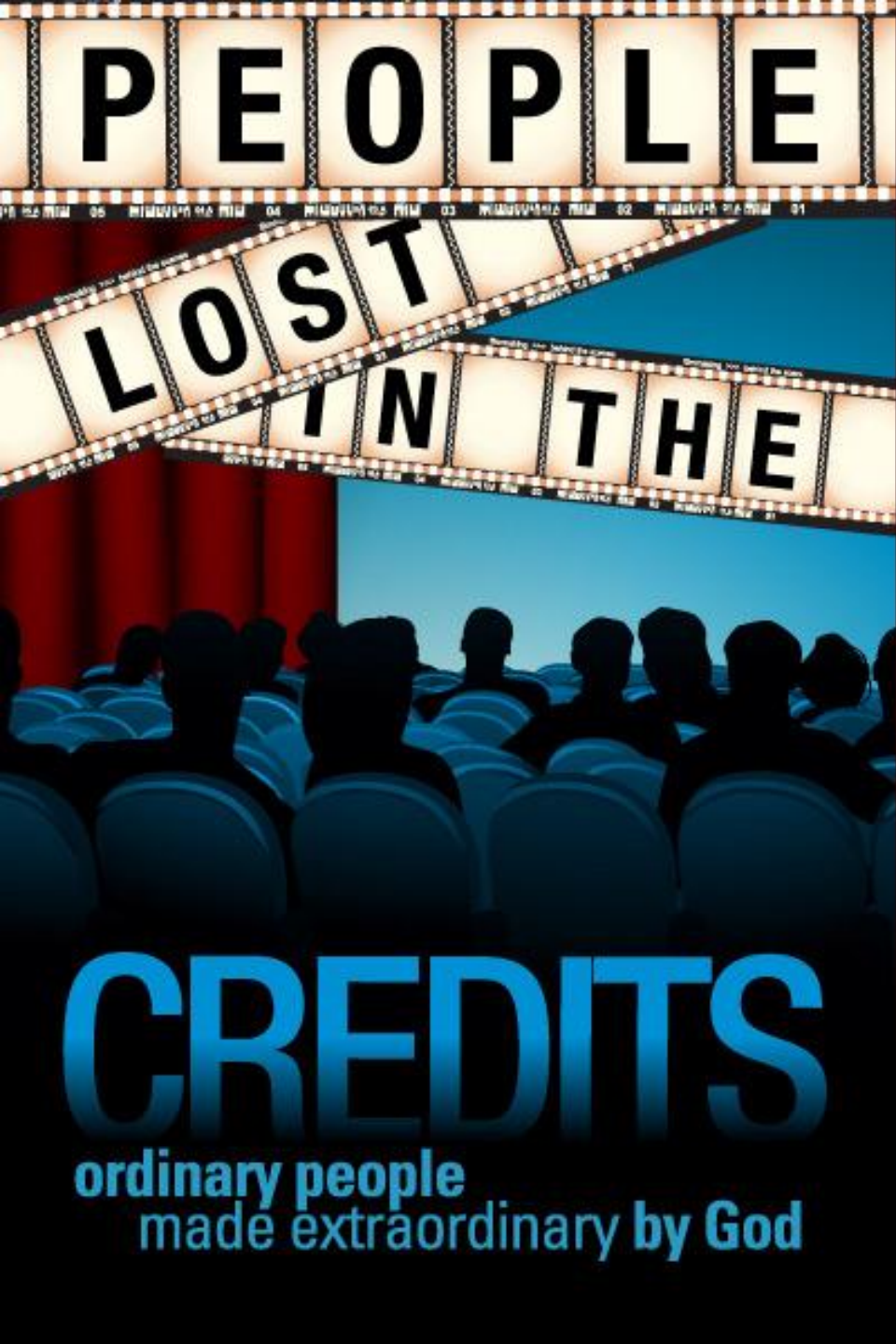
ordinary people

Bartimaeus

He did not allow his physical infirmity to drive him from God.

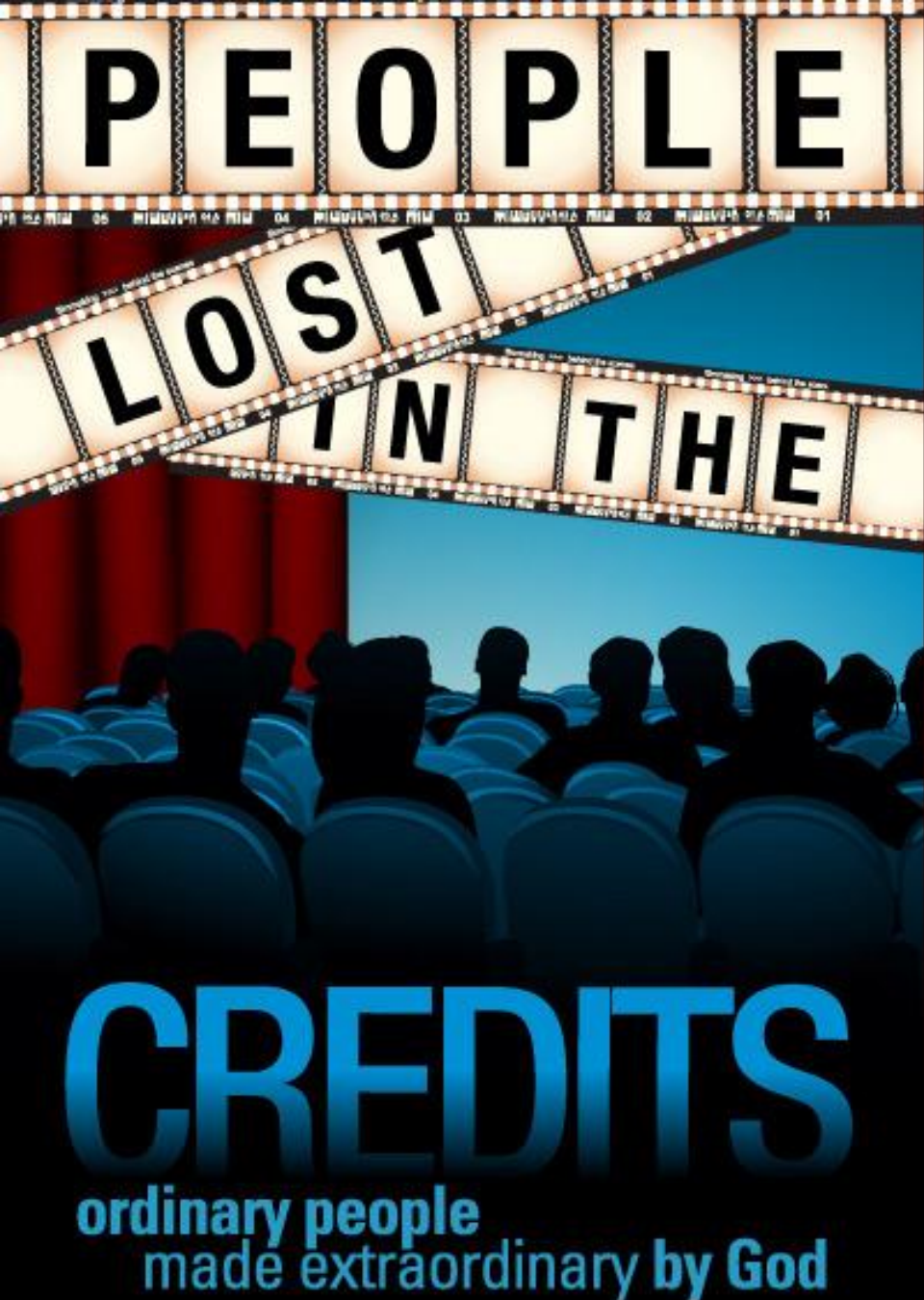
- Many become bitter when trouble comes.
- Job 1:20; 2:9-10.
- 2 Corinthians 12:10
- John 9:3.



Bartimaeus

He didn't care what others thought.

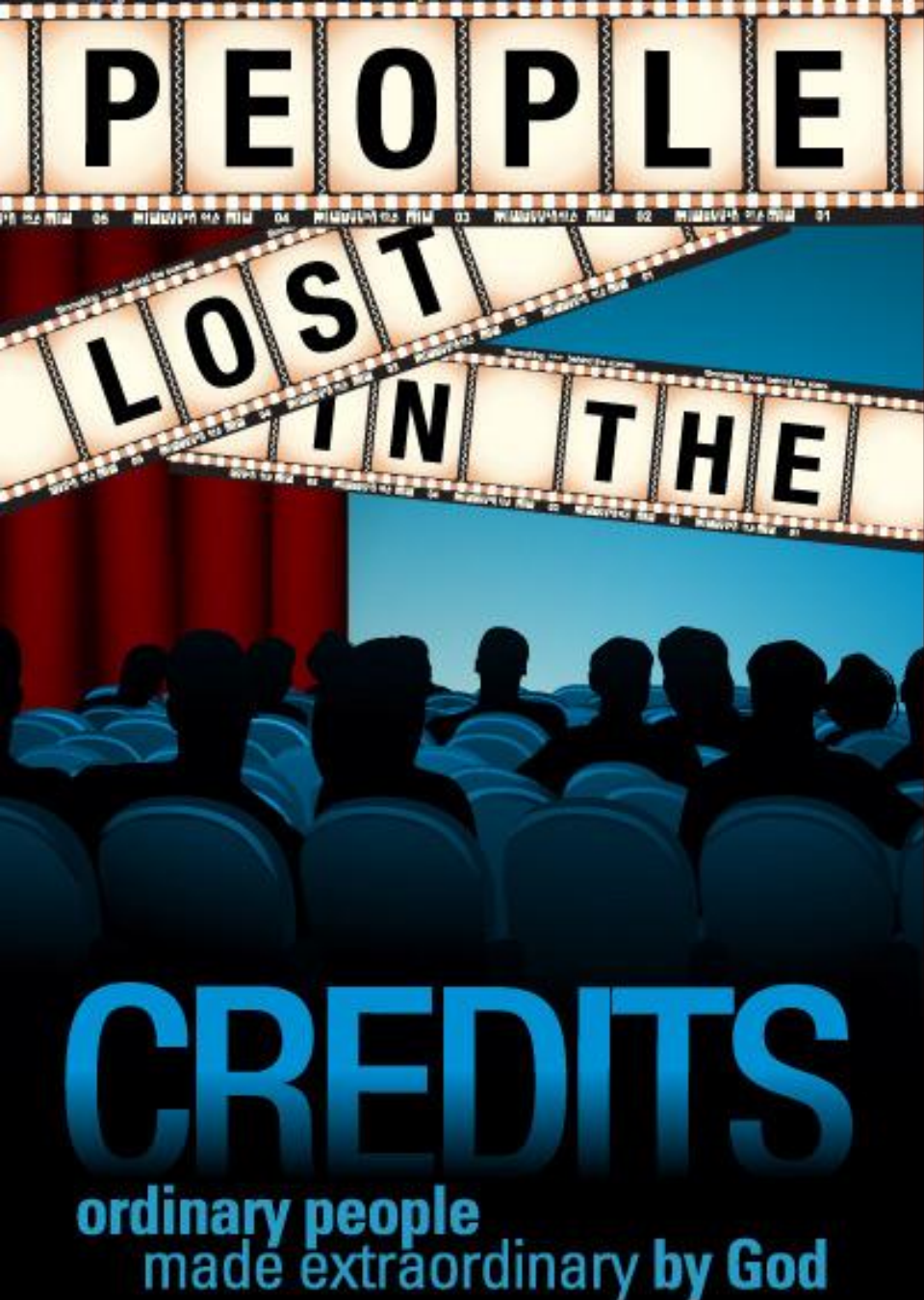
- He cried out and was repeatedly told to hush.
- Acts 4:18.
- Some are too concerned about what others think.
- 1 Corinthians 4:3.



Bartimaeus

He acted on his “once-in-a-lifetime” opportunity.

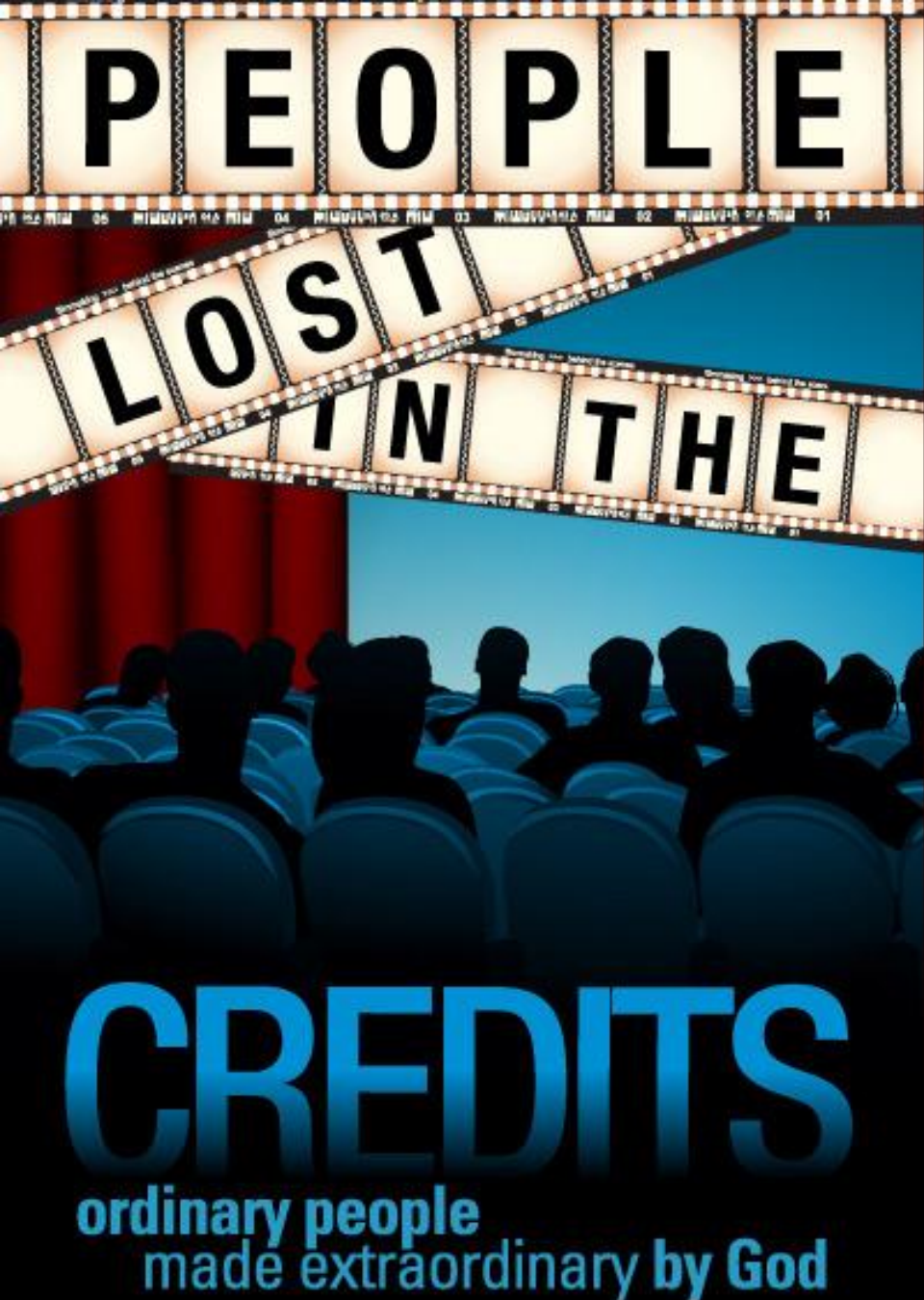
- The more he was told to be quiet, the more he cried out.
- He came with haste when Jesus called him (v. 50).
- 2 Corinthians 6:2.



Bartimaeus

He Followed Jesus.

- He didn't get what he wanted then go his own way.
- Many want Jesus as "Savior," but not "Lord."
- Matthew 16:24.
