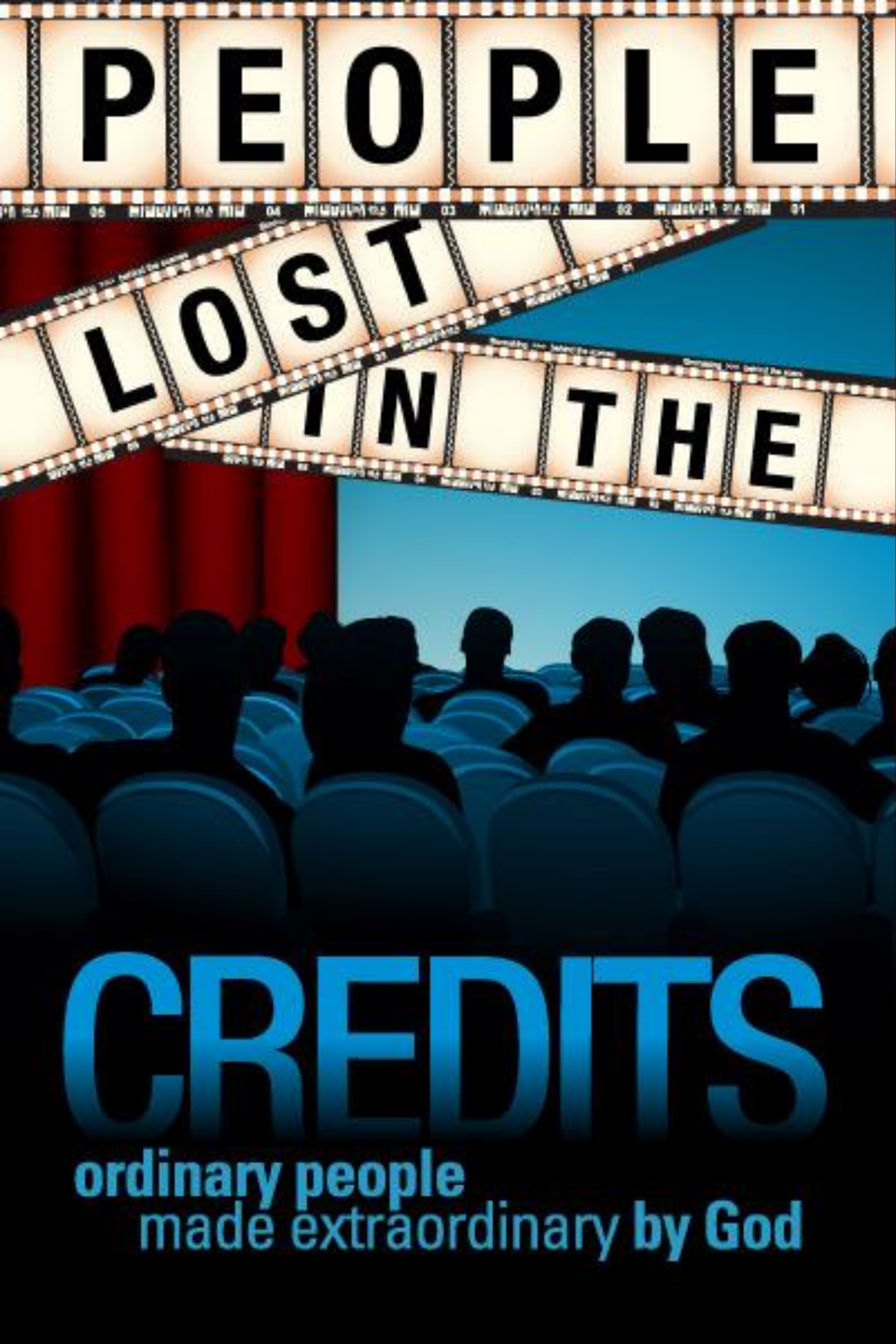


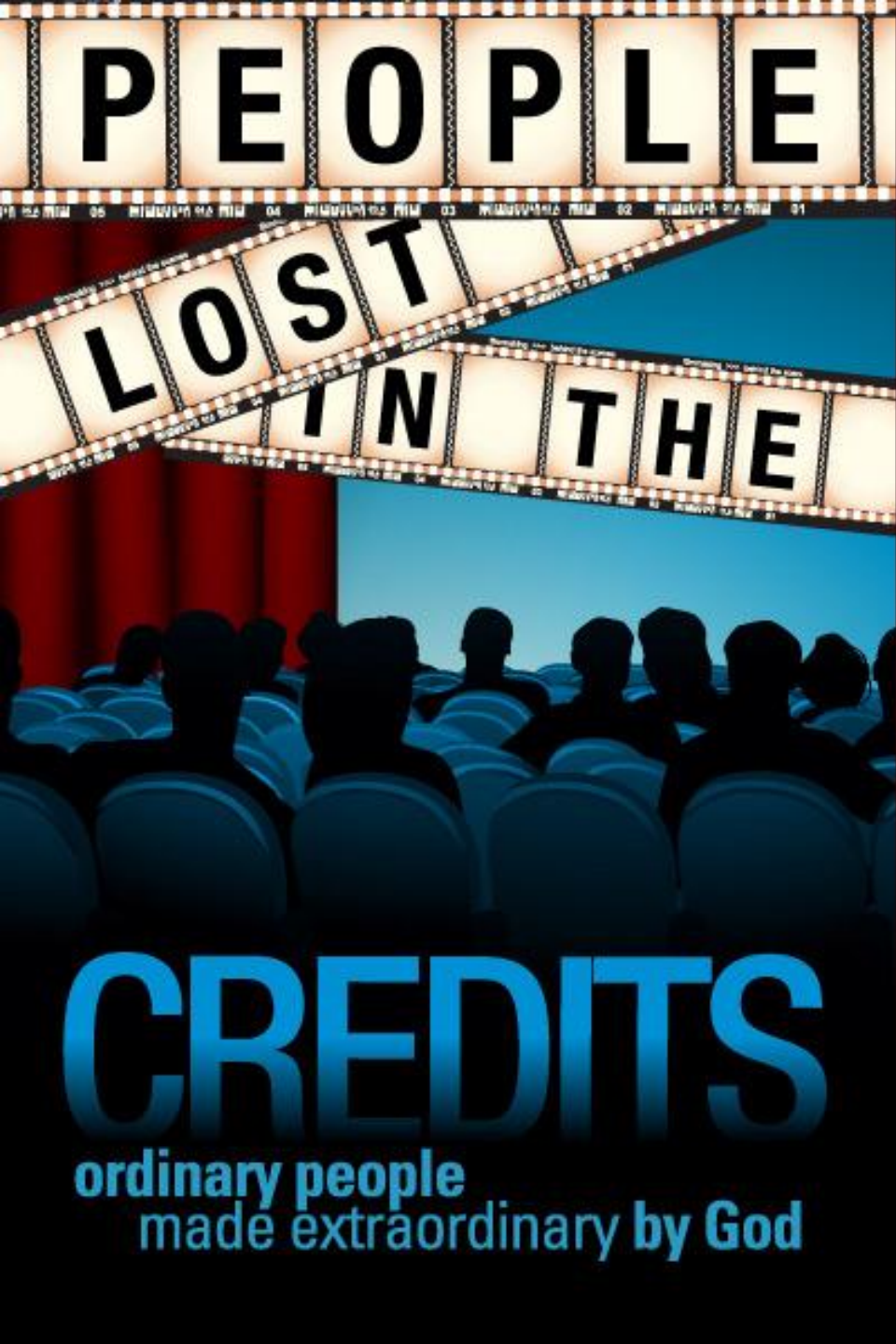

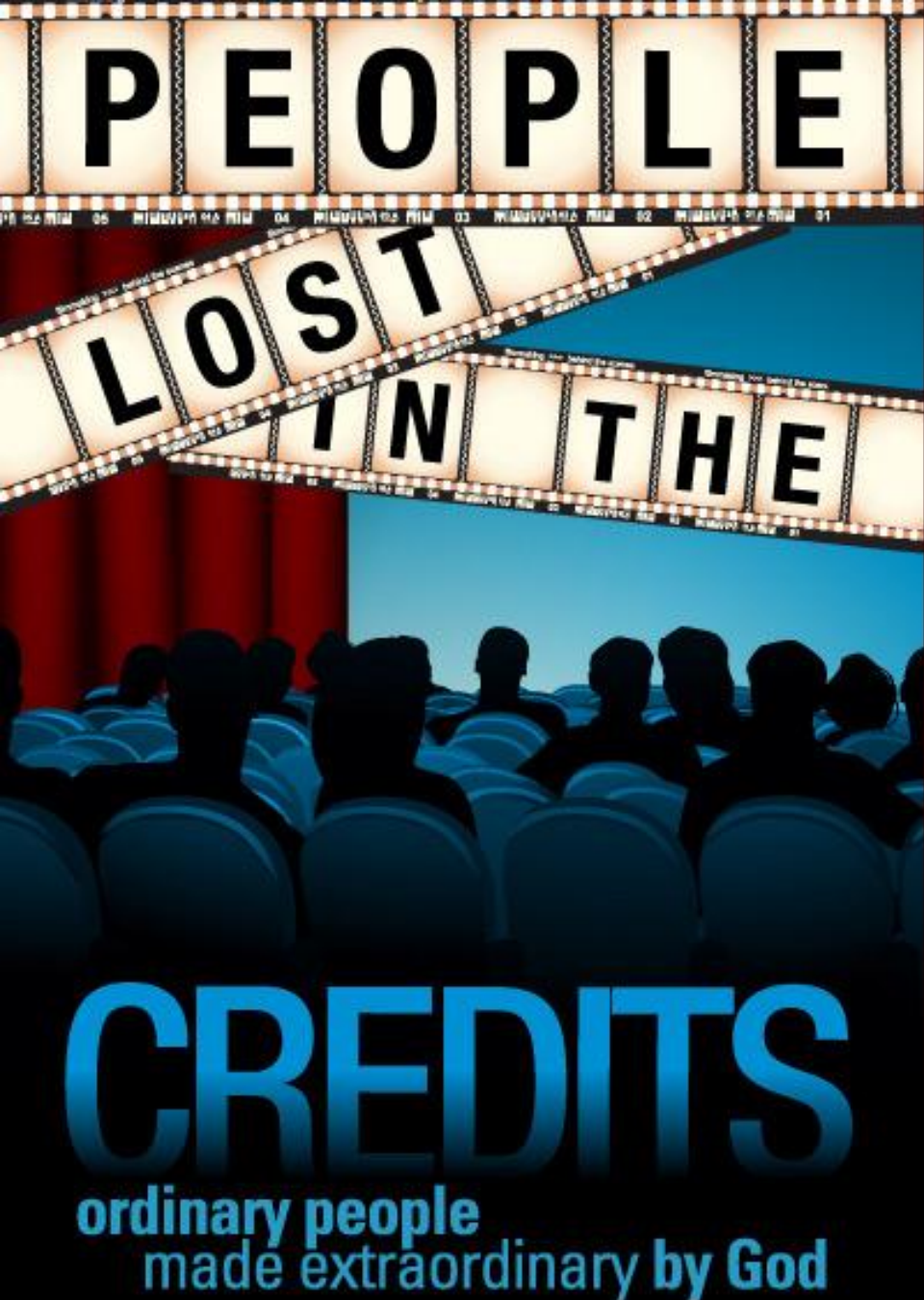

- The Altar of Burnt Offering

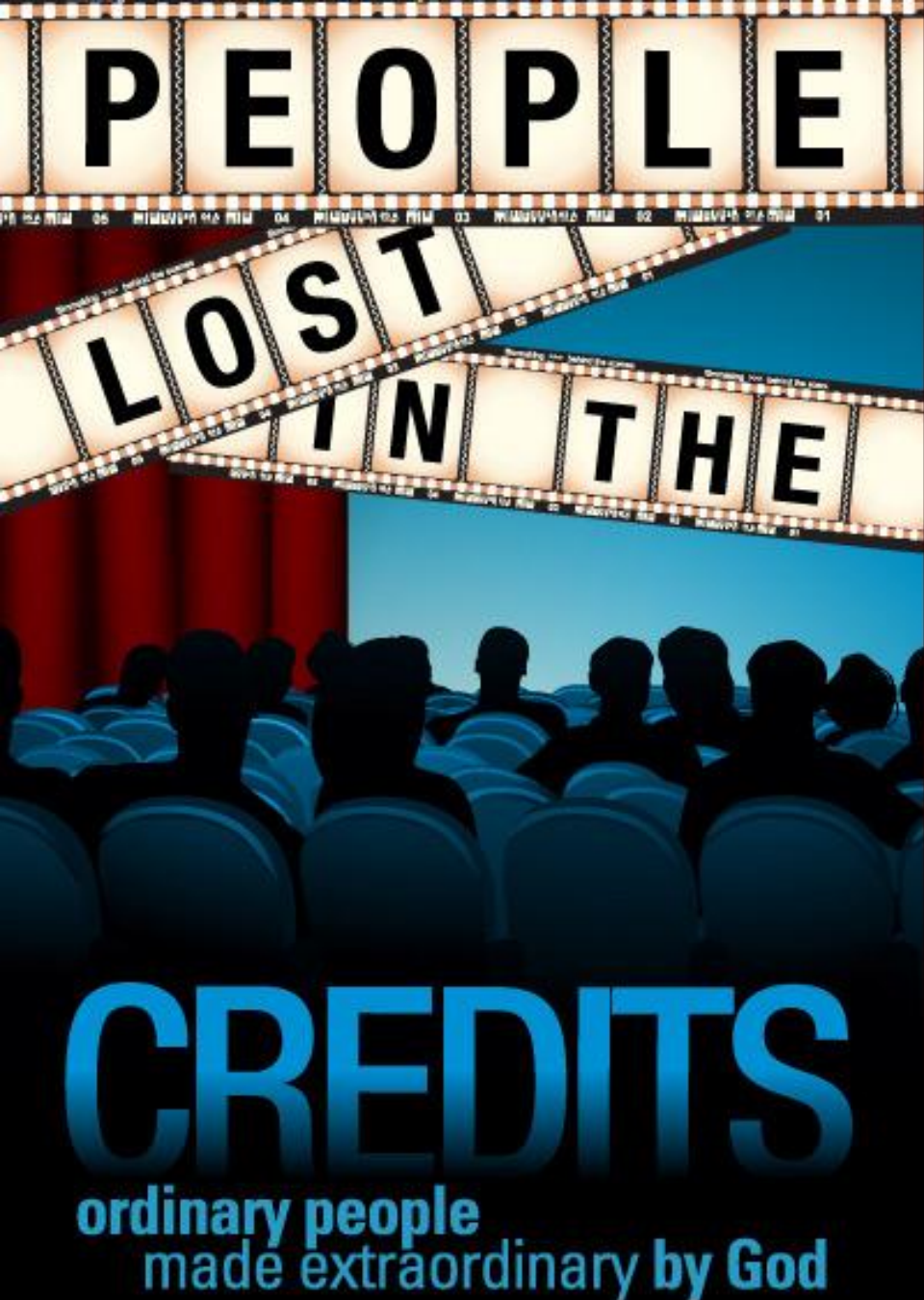

- The Bronze Laver

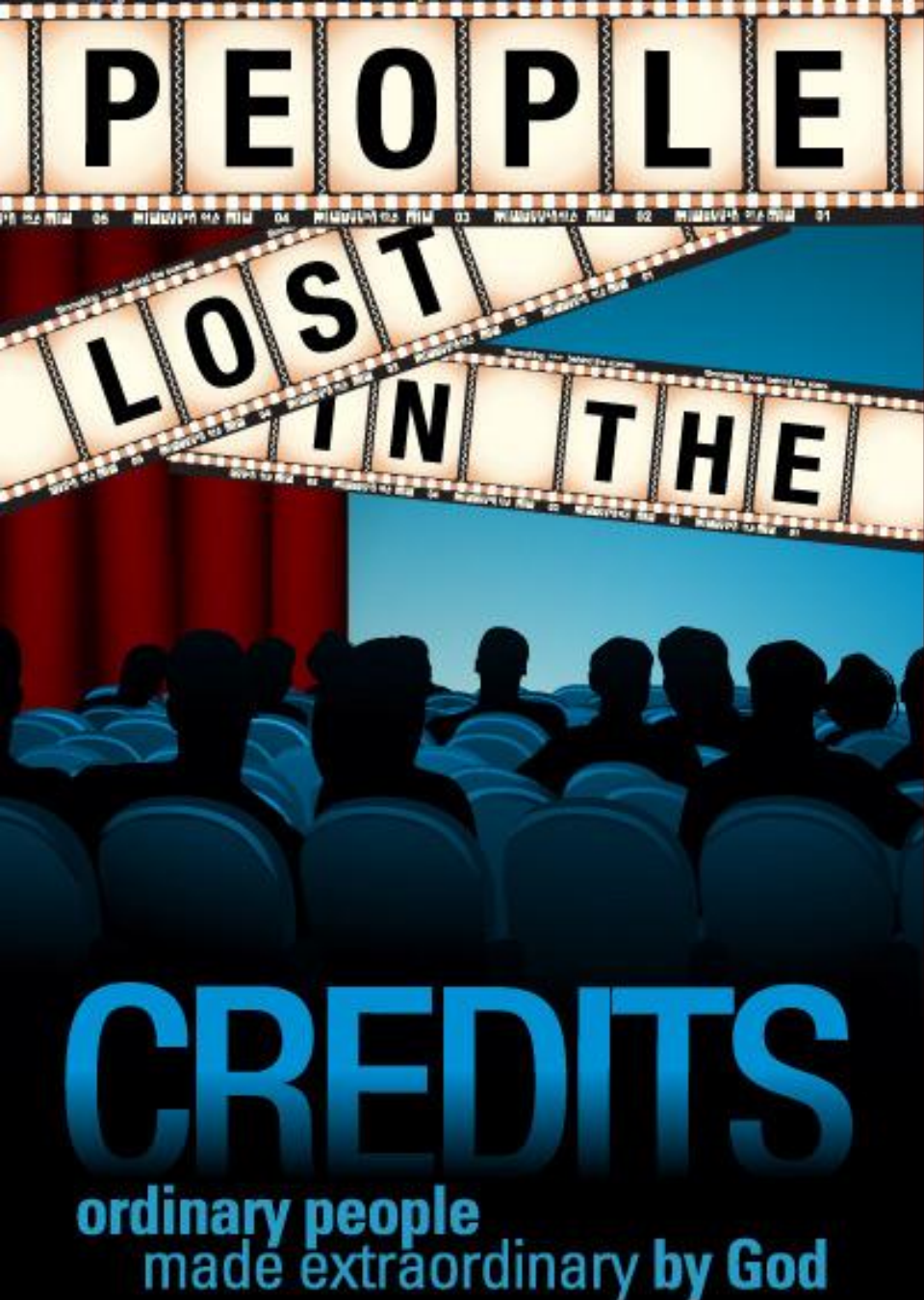

- The Golden Lampstand

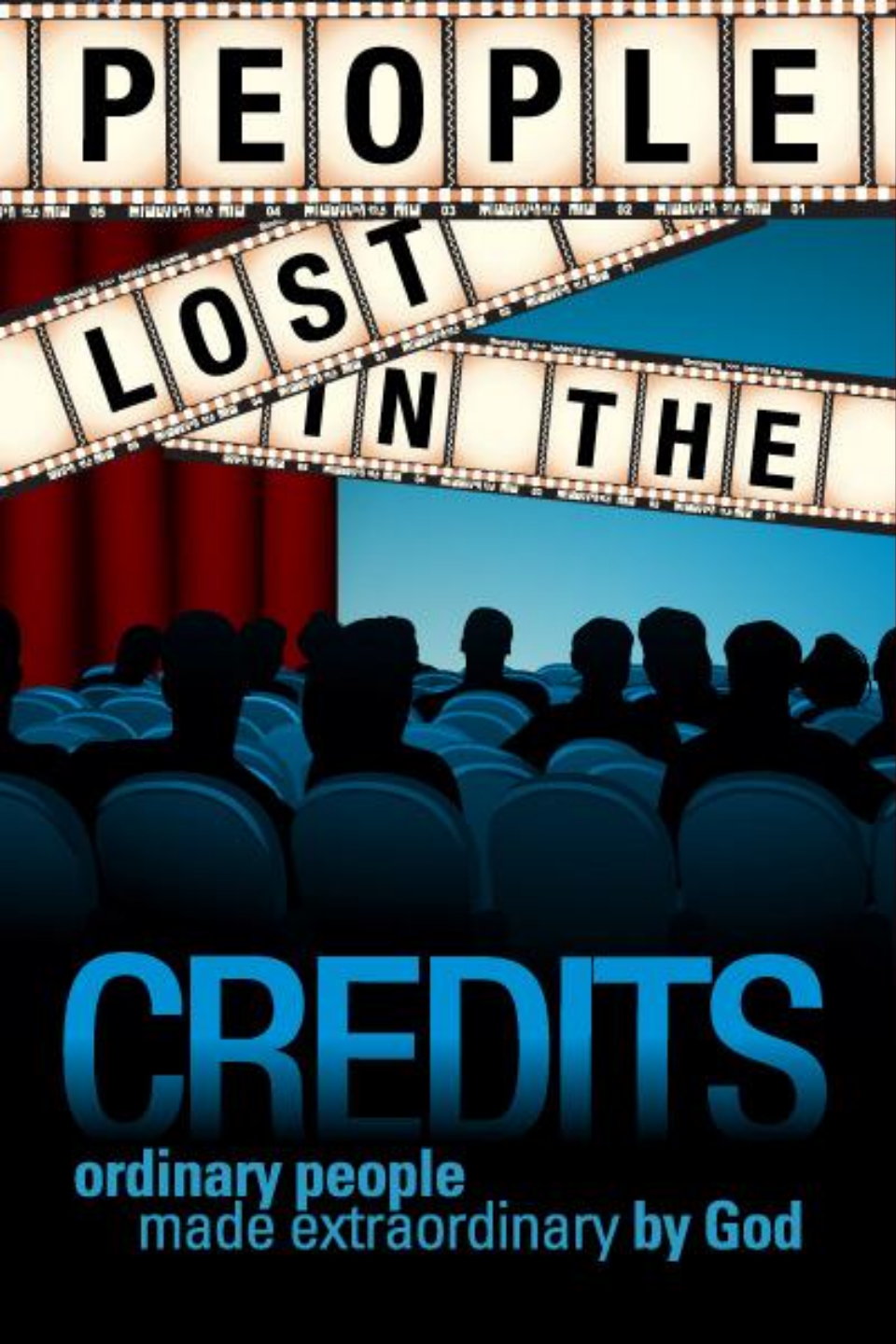

- The Altar of Incense

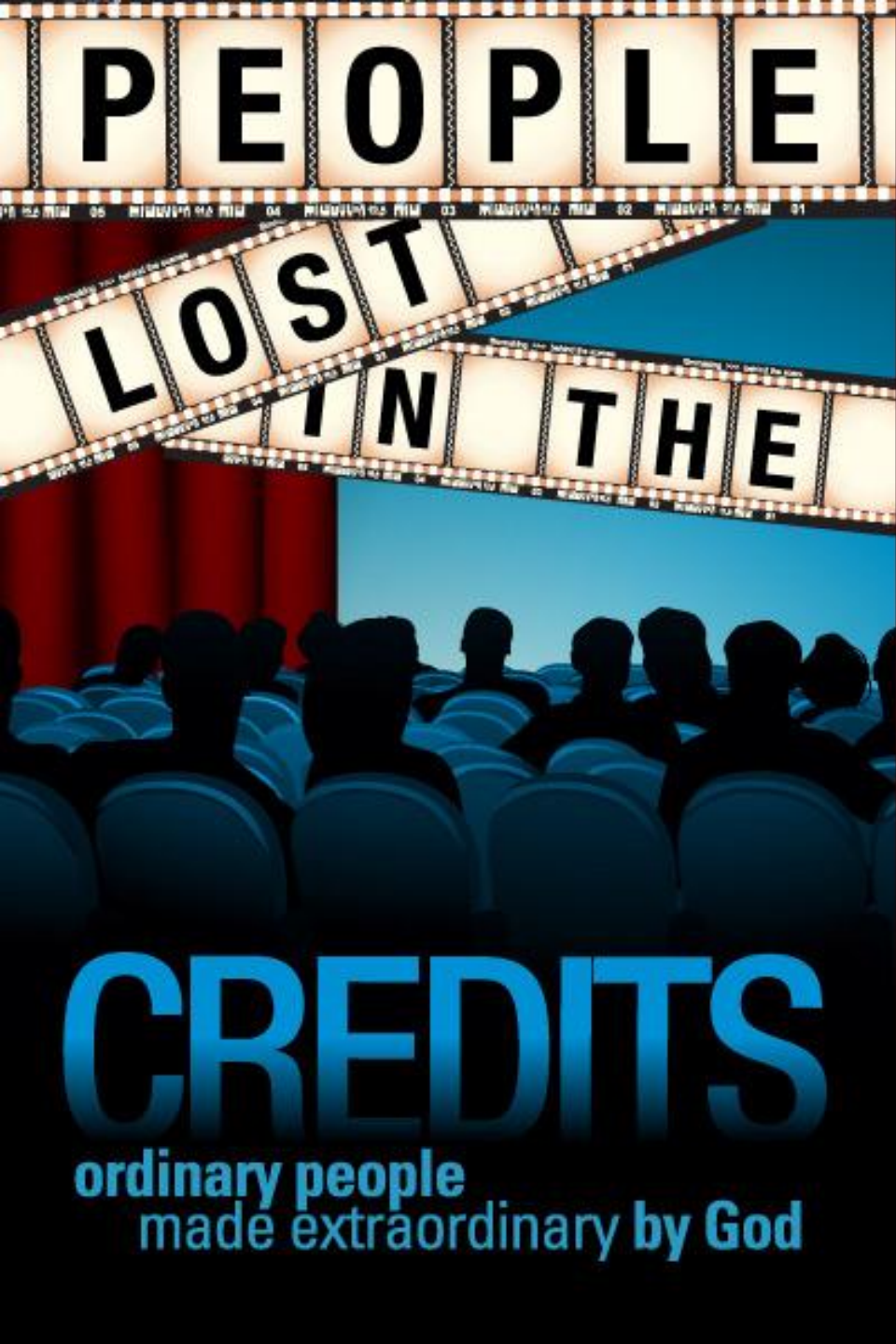

- The Table of Showbread



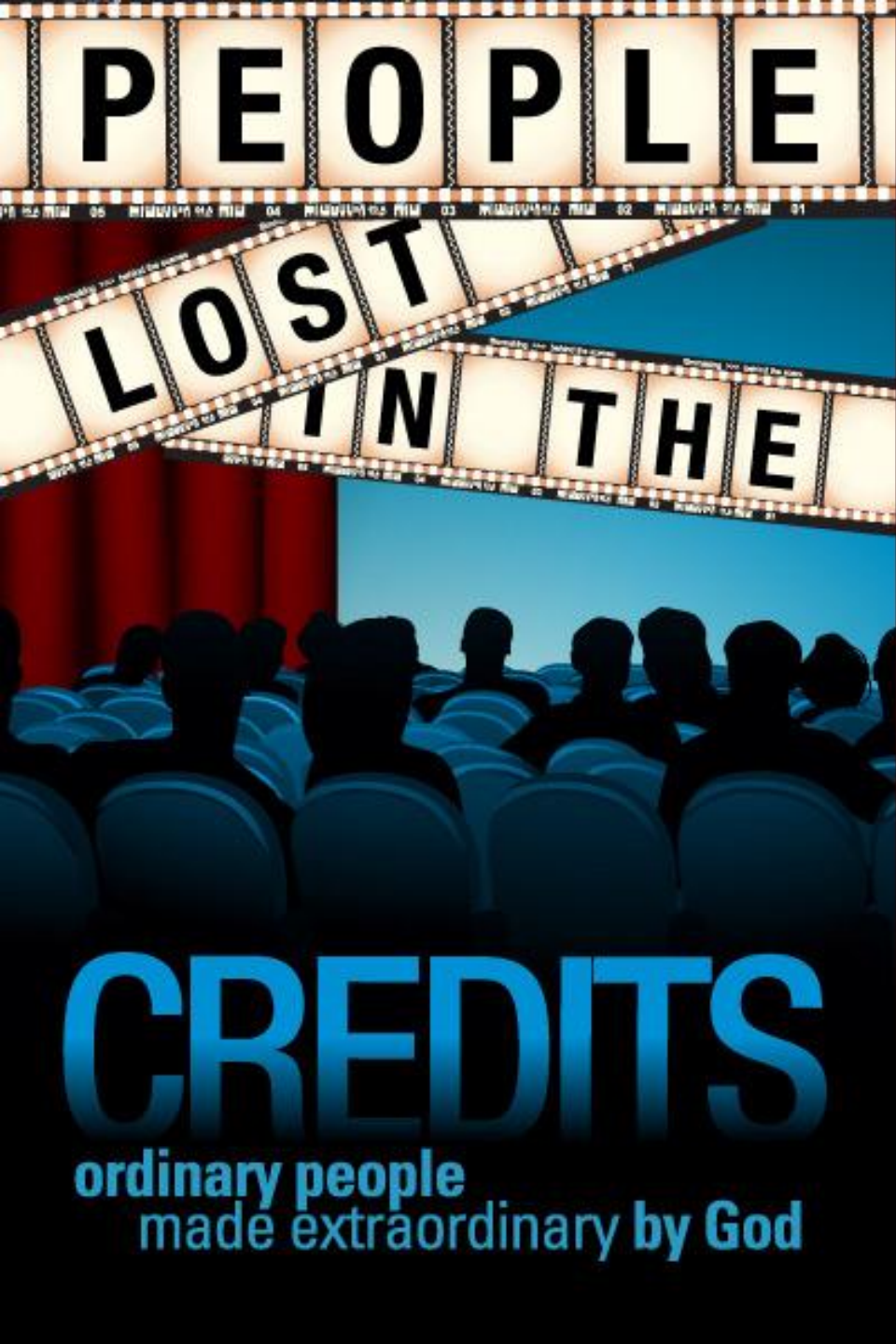

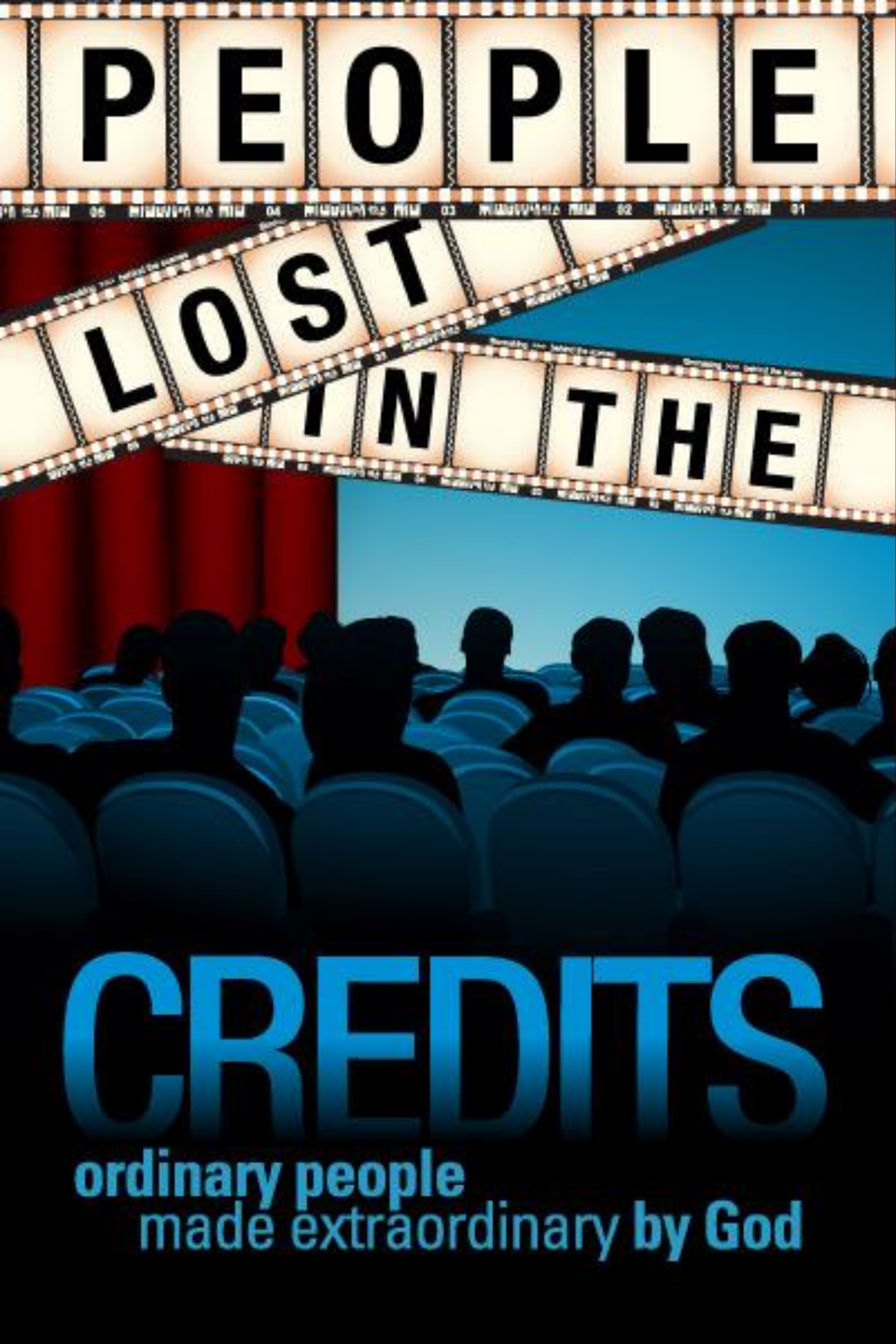

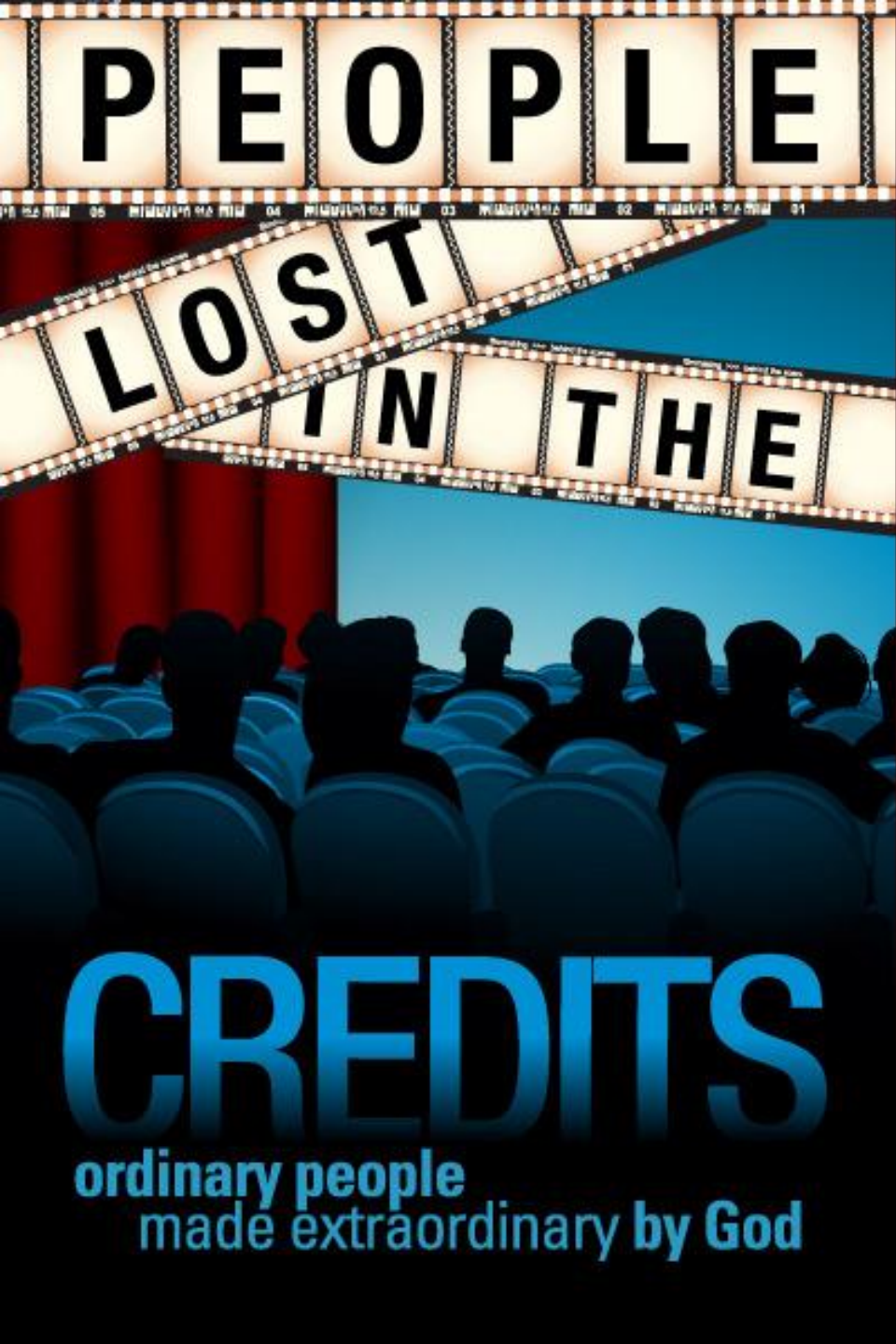
# Bezaleel & Aholiab

  - What kind of legacy are you leaving your family?



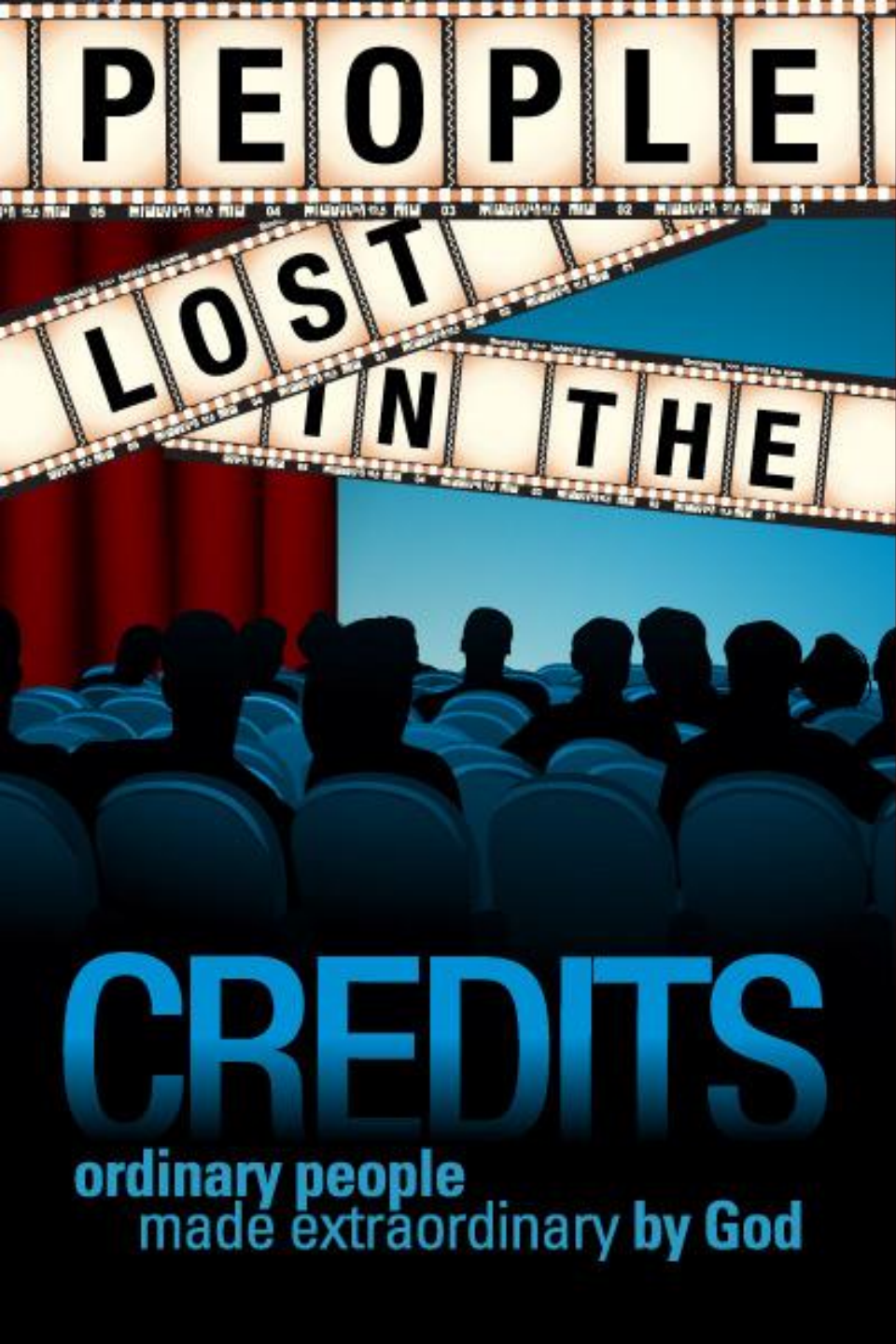
# Bezaleel & Aholiab
