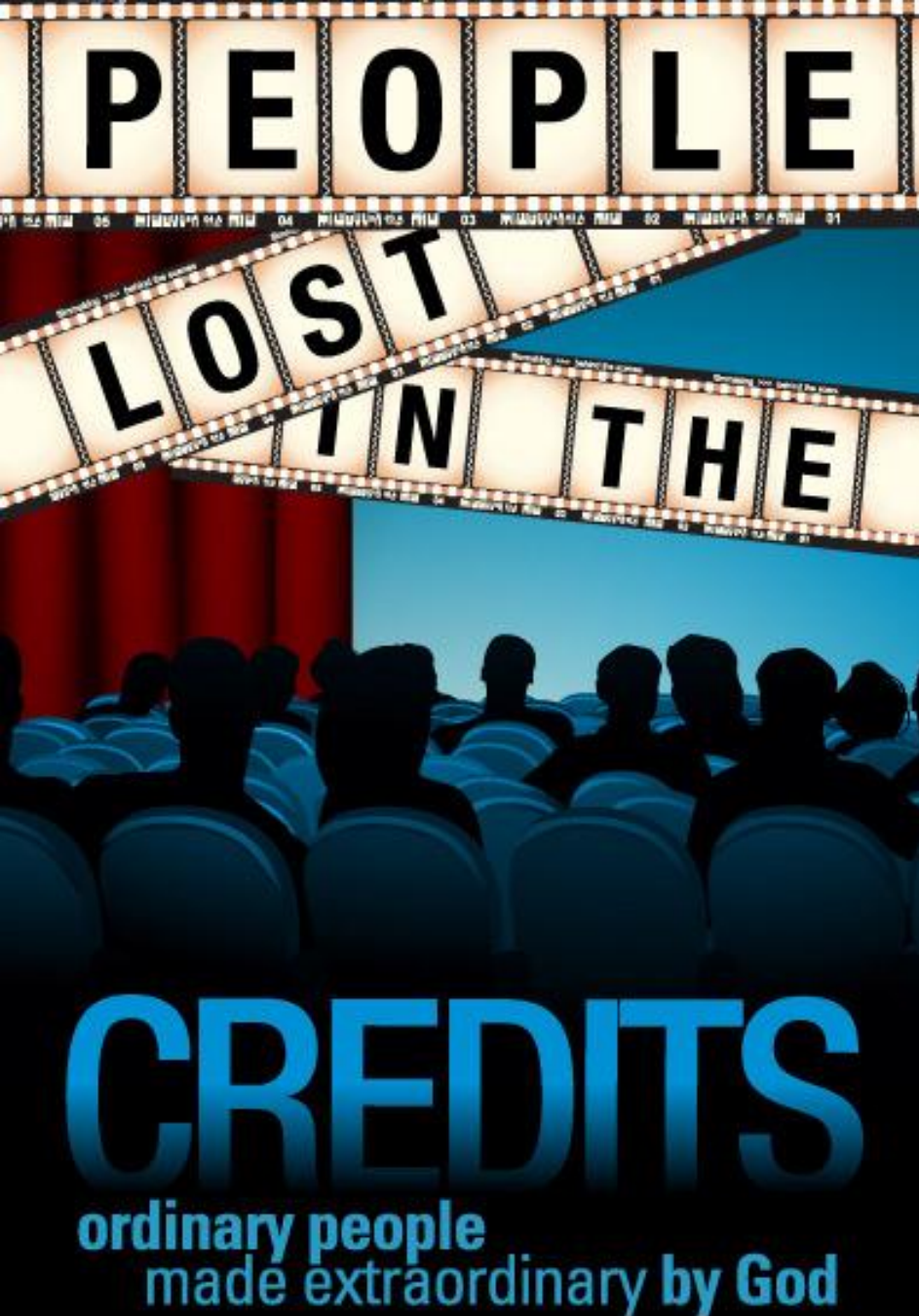

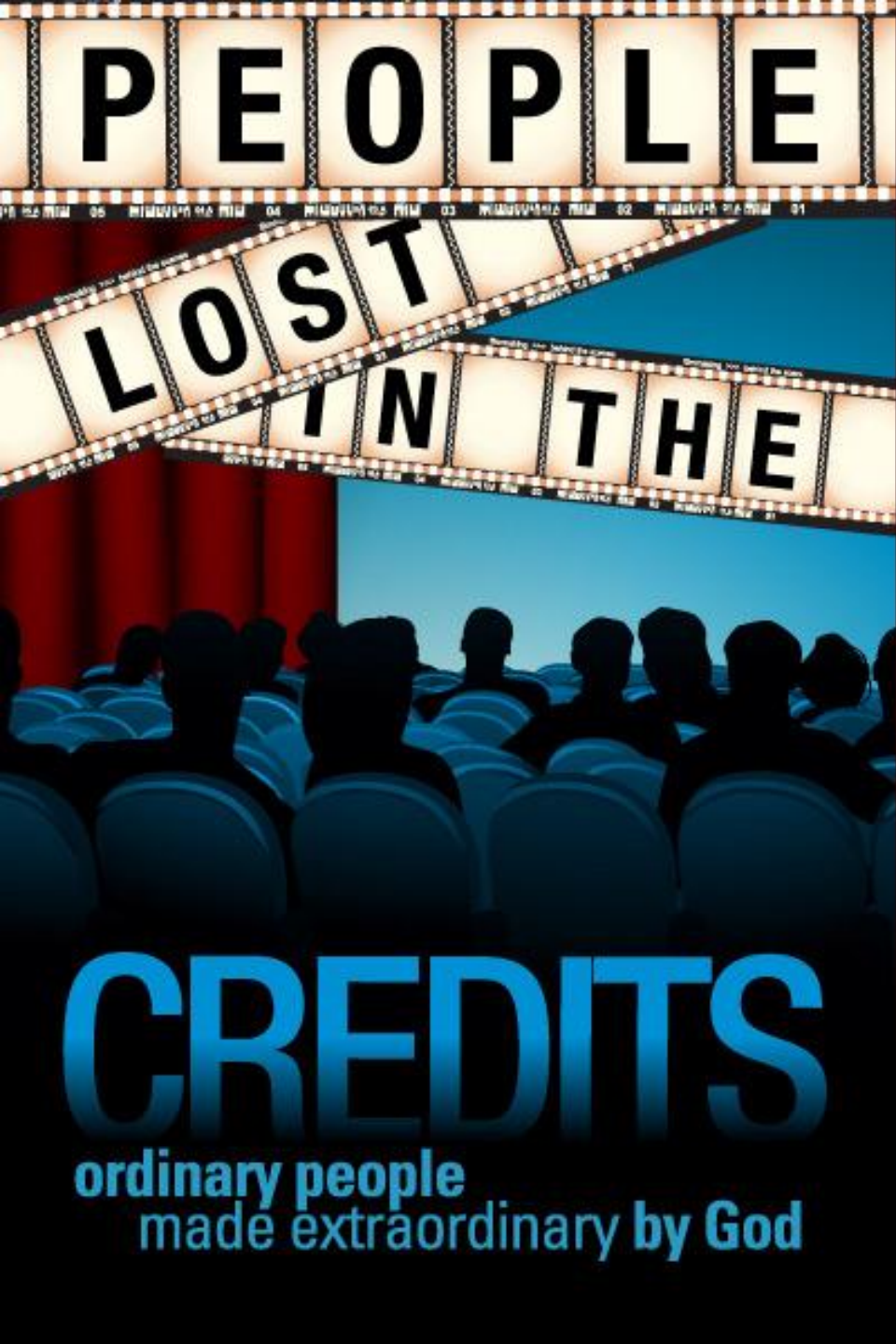


# A Foolish Legacy

- Do we ever hurt ourselves to make a point?

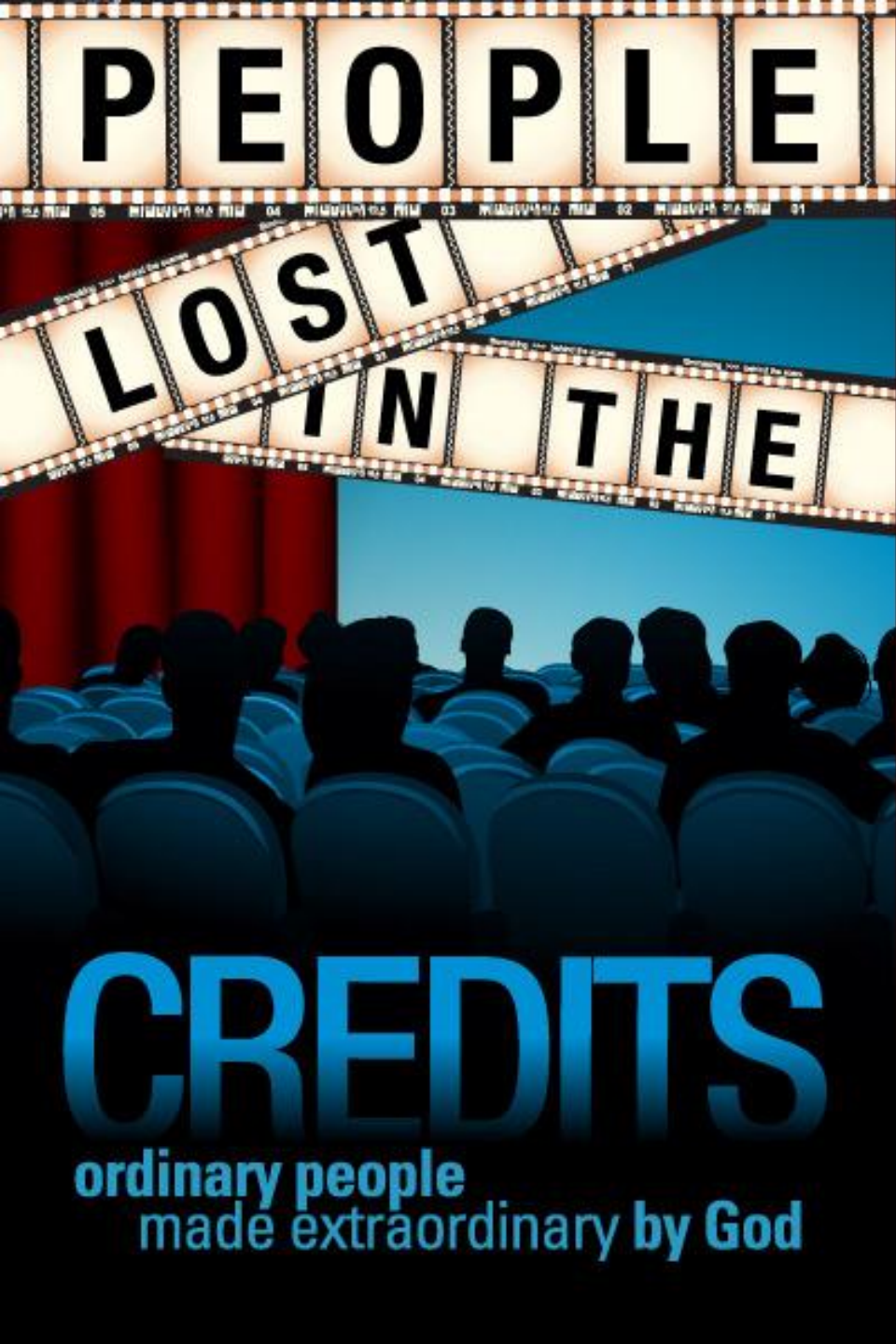




# A Foolish Legacy

  - (1 Thess. 5:12-13; Hebrews 13:17).

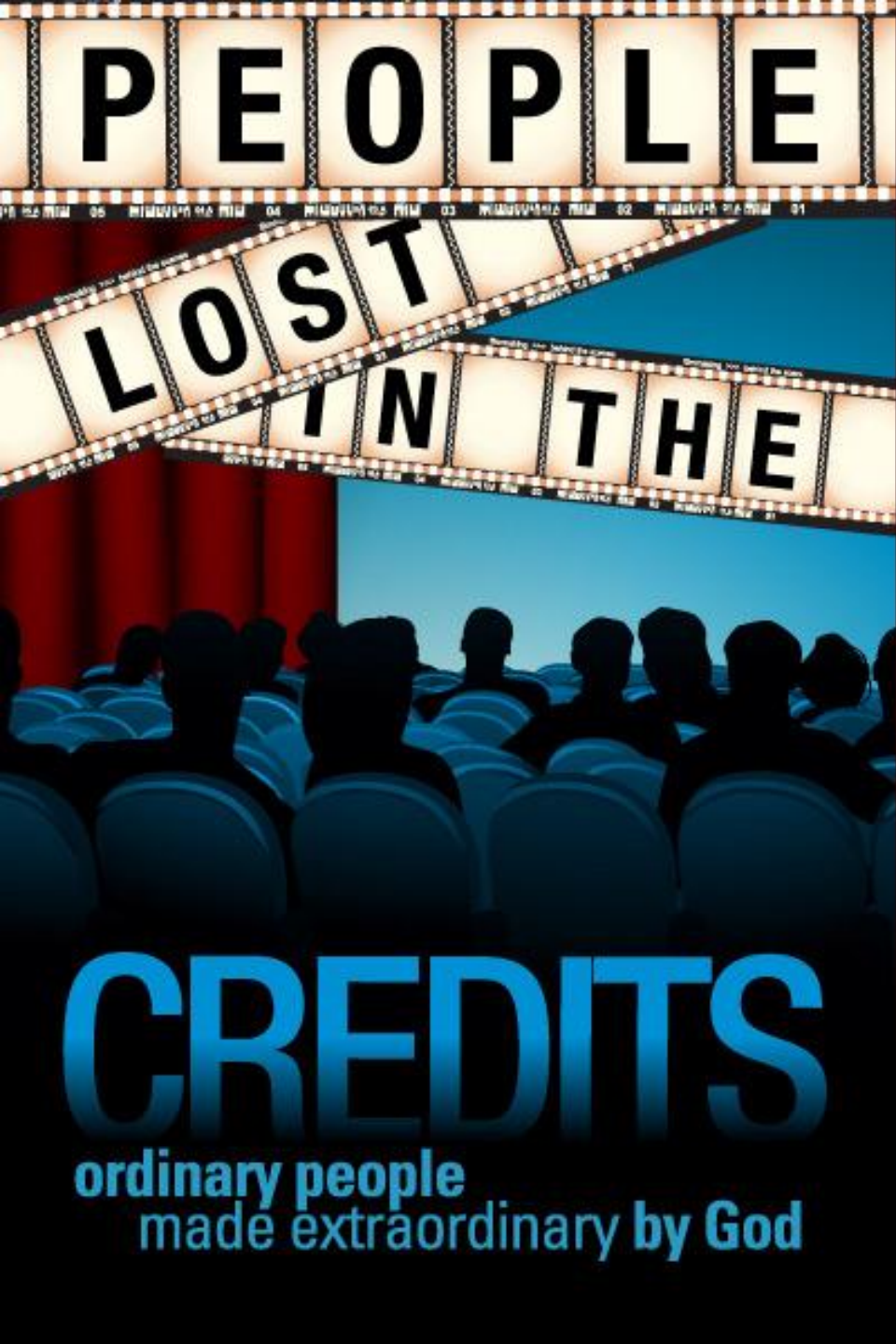


# A Foolish Legacy
