"Judge With Righteous Judgment" (John 7:31-34)

Introduction: 1. To be a disciple of Jesus, we must be one who respects and obeys the words of Jesus.

- 2. On a superficial level, it's easy to love the person of Jesus, but sometimes it's much harder to love the words that he taught.
- 3. However, who Jesus was and what he said cannot be separated.
- 4. We must love both (Mark 8:38).

I. The Red Letters Of Jesus

A. Jesus answered and said to them, "I did one work, and you all marvel. M oses therefore gave you circumcision (not that it is from Moses, but from the fathers), and you circumcise a man on the Sabbath. If a man receives circumcision on the Sabbath, so that the law of Moses should not be broken, are you angry with Me because I made a man completely well on the Sabbath? Do not judge according to appearance, but judge with righteous judgment" (John 7:21-22).

II. An Examination Of These Words

- A. There is a type of Judgment we are not to do.
 - 1. (John 7:24).
 - 2. (Matthew 7:1-5).
 - 3. Judgment according to appearance (John 7:74).
 - 4. Hypocritical judgment is forbidden (Romans 2:1).
 - 5. Judgment of motives is forbidden (1 Corithians 13:5, 7).
 - 6. Judgment of others in matters of opinion (Romans 14:10).
- B. There is a type of Judgment we are to do.
 - 1. (John 7:24).
 - 2. We must judge between good and evil (Hebrews 5:14).
 - 3. We must judge between was is good and better.
 - a. (1 Sam. 15:22) Obedience is better than sacrifice.
 - b. (Ps. 37:16)Little with righteousness is better than abundance with unrighteousness.
 - c. (Ecc. 7:3) Sorrow is better than laughter.

Conclusion:

- 1. Let us make sure that we don't allow ourselves to be silenced by a society that embraces tolerance.
- 2. The world needs a moral voice, a moral compass, to point people to Heaven.
- 3. Obey the words of Jesus, and judge with righteous judgment.
