(John 17:1-4)

Introduction: 1. Have you ever asked yourself, "Where's God?"

- 2. Have you ever felt that God showed up too late, or didn't show at all?
- 3. If you have, then this lesson may help you to understand why it seemed that God was late.

I. God And Time

- A. Being eternal, God isn't confined by time.
 - 1. (2 Peter 3:8).
 - 2. (Exodus 3:14).
- B. However that is not to say that God is not concerned with time.
 - 1. (Galatians 4:4).
 - 2. (John 2:4; 7:6; 7:30; 8:20).
 - 3. (John 17:4).

II. Examples Of When God Was On Time

- A. (Exodus 14) Crossing the Red Sea.
- B. (Daniel 3) Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-nego.
- C. (Daniel 6) Daniel in the Lion's Den.

III. Examples Of When God Was Late

- A. (John 11:21,32,42) The death of Lazarus.
- B. (Mark 5:21-43) The death of Jairus' daughter.
- C. (Hebrews 11:35-37) The deaths of many faithful.
- D. Then there's your story.

IV. Remember Two Things

- God is all knowing.
 - 1. Trust him (Job 40:2,8)!
- B. Don't ask the wrong question.
 - 1. How much does an hour weigh?
 - 2. What color is a mile?
 - 3. Rather than asking, "Where's God?" we should be asking, "What did God say?"
 - 4. (1 Corinthians 10:31).
 - 5. (Philippians 1:20).

Conclusion: 1. Let's learn to let God be God and trust his sovereign time.

2. When we do, we'll see that he's perfectly on time to accomplish his purposes.
