II. They Were Guilty of Idolatry

- A. (Hosea 9:10).
- B. Idolatry is anything that rivals God for first place in our lives.
 - 1. Money, Pleasure, Family.
- C. (2 Corinthians 11:2-3) God is a jealous God.
- D. (Matthew 22:37) Love God with your heart, soul, mind.

III. They Were Guilty of Conforming to the World

- A. (Hosea 7:8).
- B. (Romans 12:1-2) "Be not conformed to the world."
- C. (James 4:4; 1 John 2:15-17) "Don't love the world."
- D. How different are we from the world?

IV. They Were Guilty of Pride

- A. (Hosea 5:5).
- B. (Proverbs 6:17; 16:18) "Pride goes before destruction."
- C. Pride causes us to:
 - 1. Think too highly of ourselves (Romans 12:3).
 - 2. Look down on others (Luke 18:10-14).
 - 3. Look back instead of forward (Revelation 3:1-6).

V. They Were Guilty of a Lack of Knowledge

- A. (Hosea 4:6).
- B. (Psalms 119:105) "Your word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path."
- C. What can we do to prevent this?
