 - Divisiveness (Romans 16:17).
 - Walking disorderly (2 Thess. 3:6,14).

- The elders should take the lead
 - (Hebrews 13:17; 1 Peter 5:3)
- The church should follow their lead
 - (1 Corinthians 5:4-5).

How To Treat Those Disciplined?


- Do not keep company with them (2 Thess. 3:14; 1 Cor. 5:9-11).
