Introduction: 1. In the late 1979, "Sister Sledge" had a number one hit entitled, "We Are Family."

- 2. That song was then "adopted" by the Pittsburgh Pirates as they used that song to rally behind, winning the World Series that same season.
- 3. What the song reminded people of is the truth that we don't have to be flesh and blood to be family.
- 4. For many, today is a day of family celebration, and yet for others, it is a painful reminder of loss.
- 5. But for the child of God, whether you have flesh and blood family or not, we can celebrate family; God's family.

## I. The Church is The Family of God

- B. When we were baptized into Christ, we come up out of the water as members of a different family, and sons and daughters of a different Father.

- D. While we should value the fact that the church is a family, we must be careful that our message doesn't morph into "our church is for families."
