Advice for Preachers

(2 Timothy 4:1-5)

Introduction:

- 1. When I started preaching, and while I preached, I had a tremendous advantage over some men because I had a Dad who had 60 plus years of experience to share with me.
- 2. To my knowledge, my Dad never told me to preach instead, he taught me the need to preach.
- 3. Some of you may not have had the benefit of good advice or experience, so while you're here, soak it up. You'll hear a lot of it. And it will serve you well.

I. Preach the Word with Longsuffering

- A. (2 Timothy 4:1-5).
- B. Not all truth is grasped and embraced immediately
 - 1. (Acts 2:38-39) Preached that the Gentiles were included.
 - 2. (Acts 10:34-35) Years later, the "light comes on" that Gentiles were included.
- C. Not all who are mistaken are rebellious God-Haters.
 - 1. (Acts 23:1) Paul lived in all good conscience.
 - 2. (Acts 18:24-26) Apollos was a good man, but mistaken.
- D. All truth doesn't have to be immediately imparted (John 16:12-14).
- E. Think of the money that is wasted as moving trucks pass each other on the highway every Summer!
 - 1. If you don't practice "longsuffering," you might as keep your belongings in boxes.
 - 2. How much money is wasted by churches "shuffling" preachers around when a little "longsuffering" could allow that money be spent of mission work?

II. Love Peace More than Conflict

- A. After sharpening your sword for two years, you'll want to "try it out." I get it, I've been there myself.
- B. But through the years, I've learned to love peace more than conflict.
 - 1. That doesn't mean I don't believe in conflict, that I shy away from conflict, or that I am soft on error.
 - 2. What it means is that I prefer the pursue diplomacy over "fisticuffs".
- B. (1 Corinthians 9:26) If we throw punches at everything we don't like, we'll be spent (for those too young to remember, look up Muhammad Ali's "rope-a-dope.").
- C. (Matthew 5:9) Not just a "peace-keeper," but a "peacemaker."
- D. (Psalm 133:1) Unity is both, good and pleasant.
- E. Be careful on social media; watch your speech; don't use Jesus as an excuse to be mean-spirited and unkind.

Conclusion:

- 1. I believe these two pieces of advice that were given to me by my Dad, are worth passing along to you as well.
- 2. These principles have served me well, and have helped me to remain balanced, and I believe they will do the same for you.
