- 5. What a tragedy if we rob ourselves by replacing our joy and happiness with fear and anxiety.

- A. The best day ever will be the Day of Judgment.
- B. Yet, this is often considered as a day of fear and dread by God's children.
- C. How often when we talk about the Day of Judgment do we speak of warnings, destruction, eternal fire, unpreparedness, regret, and agony?

- D. While these things will exist for the ungodly, this is not what the children of God will experience.
- E. Instead of talking about what will happen to the ungodly on the Day of Judgment, why shouldn't we be talking about what will happen to the godly on the Day of Judgment?
