When God Laughs

(Psalm 2:1-12)

Introduction: 1. It is helpful to see God in his fulness if we want to have a proper understanding of who he is.

- 2. Failing to speak of one of his attributes, causes people to have a perverted view of God.
- 3. Psalms 2 shares an interesting truth about God He laughs!
- 4. The impact of his laughter is both frightening and reassuring, and I want to demonstrate this truth as we examine this text.

I. The Nations Rage

- A. (Psalm 2:1-3).
- B. The world plots against the will of God.
 - Plot same word that is translated "meditate."
- C. They seek to break the restraints God has placed upon them.
- D. We live in a time when men have plotted together to throw off the restraints of God.
- E. They have joined forces, and united in their war against God.

II. God Sits On His Throne

- A. (Psalm 2:4-9).
- B. While the nations plot, God sits.
- C. There is no pacing, no worry, no concern that his plans might be overthrown.
- D. God laughs (v. 4).
 - 1. This laughter causes fear among his enemies.
 - 2. But it causes relief among God's servants.

III. God's Offer

- A. (Psalm 2:10-12).
- B. God is a God of second chances.
- C. He doesn't just destroy them for their vain plotting, but encourages them to change their ways.

Conclusion:

- 1. God has authority over this world.
- 2. We may plot and scheme against him. We may find comfort in popular opinion. But on the day of Judgment, our plans and friends will cause God to laugh in derision.
- 3. Turn to him now and be blessed by his kindness.
