# **Out of Darkness & Into the Light**

(John 3:1-21)

Introduction: 1. We're introduced to a great story that unfolds in the book of John about a man named Nicodemus.

- 2. His story was so compelling a song was written about him by William T. Sleeper, entitled, "You Must Be Born Again."
  - A ruler once came to Jesus by night a. To ask Him the way of salvation and light; The Master made answer in words true and plain, "Ye must be born again."
- 3. In this lesson, I would like us to see a progression in Nicodemus' life that brought him out of the darkness and into the light.

#### I. **Nicodemus Heard Jesus**

- A. (John 3:1-21).
- В. Note that the text says that Nicodemus came to Jesus by night.
  - If this were the only place that is mentioned, one might think he got off work late or some other benign reason.
  - 2. However, it's mentioned all three times in Scripture when Nicodemus is mentioned.
- C. I am led to believe he was afraid to be seen – he had much to lose.
- D. Jesus teaches him about the new birth and how to be saved.

## II. **Nicodemus Helped Jesus**

- A. (John 7:45-52).
- The Nicodemus's fellow rulers scoffed at the idea of Jesus being the Messiah, В. and put a great deal of peer pressure on him.
- But in spite of the peer pressure, Nicodemus defends Jesus. C.

### III. Nicodemus Honored Jesus

- A. (John 19:38-42).
- B. Following Jesus' death, Nicodemus comes out of the shadows and makes everyone aware of where he stands.
- C. Nicodemus, along with Joseph of Arimathea asked for the body of Jesus and prepared it for burial.
