- 3. Our behavior affects others...mostly the ones we love the most in life.
- 4. Therefore, we need to give care to our influence.
- 5. Who else would we turn to for an example of how to wield our influence than to Jesus?

I. The Reason For Jesus' Actions

- A. We all know that Jesus made many sacrifices for us and called us to follow in his footsteps.
- B. (2 Corinthians 8:9).
- C. (1 Peter 2:21).
- D. But this passage tells us why Jesus did what he did.
 - 1. (John 17:19).
 - 2. (Hebrews 12:2).
- E. Don't underestimate the power of your influence.
- F. Also note that our sanctification comes through the word.

II. The Reality of Jesus' Actions

- A. The deeds that Jesus performed were not feigned, but real!
- B. (1 Peter 2:22).
- C. His life, love, and serve was authentic.
- D. Those closest to us will know whether our lives are real or a pretense.

III. The Respect Jesus' Actions Elicit

- A. People won't follow a hypocrite.
- B. However, people will respect authenticity and genuineness.
- C. Some of the most influential people who have ever lived were not influential due to pedigree or money, but due to sacrificial service to others.

Conclusion:

- 1. Jesus realized he needed to sanctify his life if he ever expected his disciples to be sanctified by the word.
- 2. Should we have no less expectation concerning the influence of our lives?
- 3. If we want to influence the people within our sphere of influence to be faithful children of God, then we must live sanctified lives.
