### Introduction: 1.

- 1. Of course, the title of this lesson is a play on words.
- 2. The Bible warns us not to change the word of God.
- 3. Instead of trying to change the word of God to fit our lifestyle, we need to change our life to fit the word.
- 4. "Not" is a small word but carries with it a great deal of importance: The difference between right and wrong.

## I. By Works A Man Is Justified, Not By Faith Alone

- A. (James 2:24).
- B. Man is justified by faith (Romans 5:1), lives by faith (2 Corinthians 5:7), and is saved by faith (Acts 16:31), but not by faith alone.
- C. This verse was not written to respond to those who don't think baptism is necessary.
- D. It is written as a warning to Christians.

### II. Not Everyone Who Calls Jesus "Lord" Will Be Saved

- A. (Matthew 7:21).
- B. One must be obedient (Hebrews 5:9; Luke 6:46).
- C. Again, keep in mind the application. This is not about "them," but "us."

### III. Buy The Truth And Sell It Not

- A. (Proverbs 23:23).
- B. Some sell the truth for popularity, peace, job security, comfort...
- C. (John 8:32).

### IV. Be Not Conformed To This World

- A. (Romans 12:2).
- B. (James 4:4).

- 1. Someday we will all stand before the judgment seat of God and give an account for our lives.
- 2. In that day, we cannot "untie" the impact of these words if spoken by our Lord, "I know you **NOT**."
