# Introduction: 1. Have you ever noticed in your prayers a disparity between asking and thanking?

- 2. According to Philippians 4:6, we are to do both.

### I. Give Thanks for God's Discipline

- A. (Psalm 107:11-12).
- B. God disciplines those whom he loves (Hebrews 12:5-11)?
  - 1. His discipline keeps us from harm.
  - 2. His discipline causes us to think twice.

#### II. Give Thanks for God's Word

- A. (Psalm 107:20).
- B. It is a lamp unto my feet (Psalm 119:105).
- C. Think of the messes and heartaches people bring upon themselves because they have not been led by God's word.

#### III. Give Thanks for God's Power

- A. (Psalm 107:25-29).
- B. God has the power to calm the storm when we are at "wit's end."
- C. There is nothing too hard for God (Jeremiah 32:27).
