- D. (1 Peter 3:21).

IV. The Church of Christ Doesn't Believe in Salvation by The Blood

V The Church of Christ Thinks They're Right and Everyone Else Is Wrong

- A. The Bible is right, and whoever disagrees with it is wrong (Matthew 24:35).

- C. Less time should be spent on the "who" and more should be spent on "what" is right.
