What Is A Christian?

(Acts 11:26)

Introduction: 1. The term "Christian" is almost universally recognized today.

- 2. However, very few people truly understand what a Christian is.
- 3. Many people even claim this title for themselves, when in reality they are not a Christian.
- 4. In this lesson, I seek to identify who Scripture teaches is a Christian.

I. One Like Christ – Imitation

- A. (1 Peter 2:21) leaving us an example that we should follow in his steps...
- B. (1 Corinthians 11:1) Be a follower of me...
- C. (Galatians 2:20) Christ lives in me...
- D. However, imitation alone does not make one a Christian.
- E. Ills. Imitating a Boy Scout doesn't make one a Boy Scout.

II. One In Christ – Location

- A. (Galatians 3:26-27).
 - 1. What? Sons of God.
 - 2. How? By (the) faith.
 - 3. Where In Christ Jesus
 - 4. When? For as many as have been baptized...have put on Christ.
- B. (Romans 6:3).
- C. Ills. Flood and Ark; Passover and houses with blood.

III. One For Christ – Vocation

- A. Vocation refers to our occupation.
- B. A Christian is one who lives and works for Christ.
- C. A steward, a soldier, an athlete, a servant, a spokesman...
- D. Ills. Of people who were in Christ, but through time got lazy and worldly and stopped living for Jesus.

IV. One With Christ – Destination

- A. We are with Christ now (Matthew 28:19-20) and we will be with him forever.
- B. (John 14:1-3).
- C. (1 Thessalonians 4:17).
- D. Ills. Of "Under-rower."

Conclusion:

- 1. There are many thoughts about who is a Christian, but put aside the thinking of men, and allow the word of God to answer that question.
- 2. A Christian can be identified by his imitation, location, vocation, and destination.
- 3. Are you a Christian? Do you have the right to wear the name of Christ (1 Corinthians 1:13)?
