 - 1. The product of God and thus objective.
 - 2. The product of man and thus subjective.

III. Who Has Forsaken Reason and Rationality?

- A. Atheists often chide believers as being uneducated and unscientific.
- B. Consider:
 - 1. The Law of Biogenesis.
 - 2. Embryology.
 - Paleontology.
