A Penny for Your Thoughts

(1 Corinthians 2:6-16)

Introduction: 1. Have you ever wished you could know what someone else was thinking?

- 2. We apparently have thought about that so much, we have created an idiom expressing that desire "a penny for your thoughts."
- 3. As much as I would like to know what someone is thinking at any given time, it would pale compared to my desire to know what God is thinking.
- 4. And while there are many secrets that God has not revealed and may never reveal (Deuteronomy 29:29), there are some things he thinks about that he has revealed.
- 5. In this lesson, we will establish that God has revealed what he thinks, and how that ought to impact our lives.

I. God Has Revealed His Mind To Us

- A. (1 Corinthians 2:6-16).
- B. A hidden wisdom was revealed to Paul (1 Cor. 2:6-10; Eph. 3:3-5).
- C. This wisdom was revealed through the Holy Spirit who knows the mind of God (1 Cor. 2:11-13).
- D. The natural/uninspired man could never know this wisdom (1 Cor. 2:14).
- **E.** But since it was given to Paul and the other inspired men, we should listen to them (1 Cor. 2:16).

II. How Should This Revelation Impact Us?

- A. (Deuteronomy 17:18-19).
- B. He was to *copy* the Word of God (Deuteronomy 17:18).
- C. He was to *carry* the Word of God (Deuteronomy 17:19).
- D. He was to make a *commitment* to the Word of God (Deuteronomy 17:19).
- Conclusion: 1. God has revealed in his word, a mystery that was hidden through the ages!
 - 2. Thus, we can know what God thinks!
 - 3. Is there anything more important?
 - 4. And what he thinks in revealed to us in the book you have in your hands.
 - 5. If that is the case, and it is, should we not be spending our time, copying, carrying, and making a commitment to get to know this book?
