The Seven "I AM" Statements of Jesus I AM the True Vine

(John 15:1-8)

Introduction: 1. Ills. of how a man got rich.

- 2. This lesson will bring to a close our series on the "I AM" statements from the book of John.
- 3. All of these "I AM" statements were designed to impress upon people the identity of Jesus...that he was more than a man, but the God of Heaven who visited us in the form of a man.
- 4. Let's examine his claim, "I AM the truth vine."

I. There is No Life Apart from Jesus

- A. (John 15:4-5).
- B. A branch cannot live apart from the vine.
- C. Jesus is claiming to be the source of life.
- D. Compare with (John 6:35) "I am the bread of life."

II. We Must Abide in Jesus

- A. (John 15:4).
- B. Getting into Jesus is not sufficient.
 - 1. How we get in Christ:
 - a. (Romans 6:3).
 - b. (Galatians 3:27).
 - 2. This is the beginning, not the end of salvation.
- C. Far too many people salvation as an event and not a process.
 - 1. Our initial salvation is an event (Acts 2:38).
 - 2. But staying saved is a process (1 Corinthians 9:24-27).
- D. We must bear fruit (John 15:2).

III. There Are Severe Consequences if We Don't Abide in Jesus

- A. (John 15:6).
- B. The consequences of failing to abide in Jesus and bear fruit are being cast into fire and burned.
- C. Surely, one can see the illusion to Hell (Revelation 20:15).
- D. The doctrine of "once saved, always saved" may be comforting to people, but it is a false comfort.

Conclusion:

- 1. I'm looking at a lot of "rich" people today.
- 2. But your riches weren't earned but given to you because of your connection to Jesus.
- 3. Some however may need to get connected, and some who have been connected need to bear fruit.
