I. All

- A. Not some, but all.
- B. We can't pick and choose which Scripture we are to obey.
- C. (Psalm 119:160).

II. Scripture

- A. Our focus is on Scripture, not the works of men.
- B. Ills. of a manual "It is most likely that in the Apostolic age when there was but `one Lord, one faith, and one baptism,' and no differing denominations existed, the baptism of a convert by that very act constituted him a member of the church, and at once endowed him with all the rights and privileges of full membership. In that sense, `baptism was the door into the church.' Now, it is different..."

III. Inspiration

- A. The Scriptures were not merely written by good men, but they wrote what God told them to write.
- B. (2 Peter 1:21).

IV. Doctrine

- A. Our teachings should come from the Bible.
- B. If a teaching disagrees with the Bible, it needs to be rejected.

V. Reproof

- A. The idea behind this word is "conviction."
- B. (Hebrews 11:1).

VI. Correction

- A. The Bible corrects us when we go astray
- B. (John 12:48).

VII. Instruction in Righteousness

- A. The Bible teaches us how to be holy people.
- B. (Hebrews 12:14).

VIII. Perfect, Thoroughly Furnished

- A. All we need is in the Bible.
- B. We don't need modern revelations.

IX. Unto Every Good Work

- A. The instruction for all that God wants us to be and to do is found in the Bible.
- B. The Bible is all-sufficient.
