# "Is the Devil Real and If So, Where Did He Come From?"

(1 Peter 5:8)

### Introduction: 1.

- 1. We live in a time in which many people don't believe in a real Devil.
- Barna did a survey over a decade ago in which 60% of professing Christians did not believe Satan was a real being, but only a symbol of evil.
- 3. Whereas Peter warned us about Satan (1 Peter 5:8) many today have dismissed his warning a treat Satan as a humorous, benign, fictional character.
- 4. When I think of the public relations makeover of Satan, I am reminded of what Paul said (2 Corinthians 11:4).
- 5. So, let's look at what the Bible says.

#### I. Is Satan Real

- A. If the normal sense makes good sense, seek no other sense, lest it result in nonsense.
- B. I know of no compelling evidence in Scripture that would lead me to believe he was anything less than a real personality.
  - 1. He was the deceiver of Eve (Genesis 3:13).
  - 2. The tormenter of Job (Job 1:12).
  - 3. The tempter of Jesus (Matthew 4:1-11).
  - 4. The sifter of Peter (Luke 22:31).
  - 5. The adversary of all (1 Peter 5:8).

## II. What is the Origin of Satan?

- A. We Know He Was Created.
  - 1. (John 1:1-3).
  - 2. (Colossians 1:16-17).
  - 3. (Psalm 148:1-6).
  - 4. (1 Timothy 6:16).
- B. We Know He Was Not Created Evil
  - 1. God is Holy (1 Peter 1:15-16) and hates evil (Psalm 5:4-5).
  - 2. After his creation he said that it was very good (Genesis 1:31).
- C. Then What Happened to Satan?
  - 1. Paul said he fell because of his pride (1 Timothy 3:7).
  - 2. We're also told that angels fell (2 Peter 2:4,9; Jude 6).
  - 3. It seems that Satan has a place of leadership among the angels who fell (Matthew 25:41).

- 4. Putting all of this together, we learn that because of pride, some angels sinned in leaving their own habitation, and because of their fall, they are under God's punishment.
- D. Is Satan Lucifer?
  - 1. (Isaiah 14:1-23).
  - 2. This passage addresses the king of Babylon.
  - 3. Lucifer is Latin and means "morning star," and is not a proper name.
  - 4. Lucifer, as a name of Satan was popularized by John Milton's "Paradise Lost."
  - 5. Jesus is called the "morning star" (Revelation 22:16).
- E. Ezekiel's Description of Satan
  - 1. (Ezekiel 28:11-19).
  - 2. This is a prophecy against the king of Tyre, however it clearly reaches beyond him.
    - a. He was in Eden, the garden of God (v. 13).
    - b. He was the anointed cherub (v. 14).
    - c. He was prefect from his creation till iniquity was found in him (v. 15).
    - d. He was cast out of the mountain of God (v. 16).

#### **Conclusion:**

- 1. According to the Bible, Satan is real.
- 2. He was created perfect by God, but fell because of his pride.
- 3. Today, he seeks to destroy us, so that we will share in his fate and misery.
