Introduction: 1. Within the course of one's life, he will receive, accept, and decline many invitations.

- 2. However, no invitations will be more important than the three we want to address today.
- 3. And as we examine these invitations, I want you to ask yourself if you have accepted or declined these invitations made to you by Christ.

I. COME UNTO ME

- A. (Matthew 11:28-29).
- B. (Revelation 22:17) This invitation is universal.
- C. (Romans 12:1-2) Prove what is good and acceptable...
- D. (Isaiah 1:18) Come let us reason together...
- E. What you eventually do with Jesus is your decision, but please don't refuse His invitation to investigate Him.

II. COME AFTER ME

- A. (Matthew 16:24-26).
- B. (Isaiah 1:18) Come let us reason together...
- C. (Ephesians 4:1) Walk worthy of the calling...
- D. (I Corinthians 6:19-20) We are no longer our own...
- E. Though the price of discipleship is high, the prize of salvation is worth it.

III. COME, YOU BLESSED OF MY FATHER

- A. (Matthew 25:34).
- B. (John 14:1-3) Jesus is preparing a place for us.
- C. (Revelation 21-22) A description of Heaven is given.
- Conclusion: 1. What will you do with the invitations made by Christ?
 - 2. I know the last invitation would be accepted by all if it were offered to all.
 - 3. But the last invitation is not a universal invitation, but is extended only to those who have *come unto* Jesus and *come after* Him.
