(2 Chronicles 34)

- Introduction: 1. Ills. of "Uncle Billy" who lost \$8,000.00 in the movie, "It's A Wonderful Life."
  - 2. It's a terrible thing to lose something of great value.
  - 3. The Bible records for us an incident in the history of Israel wherein the Israelites lost something of great value The Book of the Law!
  - 4. Let's see if we can learn some lessons from this story that God chose to reveal for us.

## I. Background

- A. (1 Kings 13:1-2) Prophecy is made concerning a King by the name of Josiah would take the throne.
- B. 300 years later, this prophecy comes true (2 Chronicles 34:3-5).
- C. Israel has lived under wicked rulers for the past 57 years, and during this time, they had lost the book of the Law.
- D. However, with Josiah's reforms, the book is found, read, and put into practice.

## II. Lessons We Can Learn

- A. While there has never been a time in the history of the world when more Bibles are so readily available to people, there is an ever growing ignorance of God's word.
  - 1. Ills. Of Bible missing from the courtroom...putting hand on the head of a Christian.
  - 2. Ills. Of Christian lady who could not find a passage in her Bible.
- B. Ills. Apollo 13 "Houston, we have a problem."
- C. It's possible we've lost the word of God through neglect.
  - 1. (Hebrews 5:12).
  - 2. Think of all the things we stay abreast on, yet are ignorant of the Bible.
- D. It's possible that we've lost the word through traditions.
  - 1. (Matthew 15:6).
  - 2. We've always done it this way.
- E. It's possible that we've lost the word through misplaced trust.
  - 1. (1 Kings 13:18).
  - 2. (1 John 4:1).
  - 3. (1 Timothy 4:1-2).

## III. Why We Need To Find The Book Of The Law

- A. It will give our lives stability (Luke 24:13-27).
- B. It will show us the way to Heaven (Psalm 119:105).
