



The Woman At The Well

- (John 4:1-38)
- Jesus needed to go through Samaria on his way to Galilee (4:3-4).
- There, he asked a Samaritan woman for a drink at Jacob's well (4:6-7).
- The beginnings of the Samaritans (2 Kings 17:24-29)




The Woman At The Well

- She was surprised by his request and they engaged in a spiritual conversation (4:9-26).
- The woman then left Jesus, went into the city, and asked the city to come listen to Jesus (4:27-30).
- As a result, many from the city believed (4:39-42).




The Woman At The Well

- The Longer This Woman Was With Jesus, The More Respect She Had For Him
 - Jew (v.9)
 - Sir (v.11)
 - Prophet (v.19)
 - Christ (v.29).
- "Turn your eyes upon Jesus."




The Woman At The Well

- Jesus Addressed The Woman Where She Was
- “Just As I Am.”
- Coming to Jesus demands repentance.
- He addresses her marriage relationship (4:18).
- We need to teach on this topic (Matthew 19:9).




The Woman At The Well

- The Woman Tried To Change The Subject
- Where to worship (John 4:20).
- Many try to dodge one’s personal accountability to God.
- We will be judged individually (2 Corinthians 5:10-11).



The Woman At The Well

- The Woman Shared With Others What She Knew
- You don't have to know everything to share something about Jesus.
- (John 1).
- (2 Peter 3:15).
- (2 Kings 7:9).



The Woman At The Well

- Jesus Loves All People
- No boundaries to the love of Christ.
- He died for all men (Romans 5:6-10).
