 - (Deuteronomy 23:1)
 - He travelled 2,000 miles to “stand in the foyer.”
 - (2 Timothy 2:15)
 - (John 5:39)
 - Our knowledge of God does not come from a casual look, but a diligent search.
 - (Hebrews 11:6; Psalm 9:10; 14:2; Proverbs 8:17; Matthew 6:33)



Finding God's
Treasure

- He Was Willing To LISTEN To Something New
 - He admitted he didn't understand and needed guidance (Acts 8:30-31)
 - (Isaiah 53:1-12) Jesus is the Messiah
 - This is not what he had just been taught.
 - He now had a choice...
 - Close up his Bible and end his conversation.
 - Honestly investigate this new information.



Finding God's
Treasure

- He Was Willing To LEAVE His Past
 - Go against my friends and family? Change religions? Start over? Admit I've been wrong?
 - There were others in the same situation, but who did not act as virtuous (John 12:42).
 - He was baptized by Philip and went on his way rejoicing (Acts 8:36-39).
