The Gospel of John: That You Might Believe "Peter"

(John 21)

Introduction:

- 1. Have you ever felt like you let someone down, and because of your actions, someone else gets hurt?
- 2. I've been a Christian for more than 30 years, and yet, I still at times find that I am light years away from where I should be.
- 3. During those 30 years, I've seen many victories, done many things right and well, however during that same time, I've failed too many times to be full of pride.
- 4. Think of the "ups and downs" of Peter's life as a disciple of Jesus.
- 5. Let's look at how Jesus deals with Peter and take hope in his restoration.

I. Peter Denied The Lord Three Times

- A. (John 18:15-27).
- B. (Luke 2:61) Jesus saw and heard Peter's denial.
- C. Peter ran out, weeping bitterly because of his failure.

II. The Steps To Peter's Restoration

- A. A desire for Peter is expressed.
 - 1. (Mark 16:7)
 - 2. Too often, we "write off" those who sin against us.
 - 3. (Matthew 18:21-35).
- B. A recalling of better times.
 - 1. (John 21:1-7).
 - 2. (Luke 5:1-8).
 - 3. (Revelation 2:5).
 - 4. Sometimes when we fall, it's good to go back to where it all began.
- C. A desire to be restored.
 - 1. (John 21:7).
 - 2. In his heart he still loved the Lord, but his actions were weak.
 - 3. (Psalm 25:7; Romans 7:15-25).
- D. Confrontation over the sin.
 - 1. (John 21:15-17).
 - 2. Difficulties with this section:
 - a. Do you love me more than "these."
 - b. "Agape" and "Phileo."
 - c. Three commissions three offenses.
- E. Don't shift discussion to others.
 - 1. (John 21:20-22).
 - 2. Personal confrontation is not easy, but it is necessary.

Conclusion:

- 1. Peter never stopped loving the Lord, and the Lord never stopped loving him.
- 2. However, Peter's actions required repentance and the Lord made this possible.
- 3. What about your life and your relationship with Jesus? Do you have a need to be restored?
