- D. (Daniel 3:22-26) The presence of God distracted their attention away from the flames and even had to be told to come out!
- E. Elisha (2 Kings 6:17).
- F. Does God's presence give you comfort or discomfort?

## III. Consider The Cost

- A. Jacob & Esau (Genesis 26:19-34; Hebrews 12:16-17).
- B. We have a birthright (Galatians 3:29).
- C. Have you lived long enough to get weary, to be heart-broken, to long for something better?
- D. (Luke 14:27-33) Consider the cost.
