Social Issues (Part 1) Marriage & Society

Introduction: 1. The church of Christ is not immune from being infected by contemporary social issues of the day.

- 2. There are a number of social issues that are adversely affecting our society and also affecting the Lord's church.
- 3. One of those areas is within the divine institution of marriage.
- 4. Marriage is one of three divine institutions which God created and intended for mankind's good.
 - a. Home (Genesis 2:18).
 - b. Government (Romans 13:1-7).
 - c. Church (1 Corinthians 12:12-31).
- 5. When any of these institutions are abused, the result is always harmful to mankind.
- 6. This lesson examines three contemporary challenges to the divine institution of marriage.

I. Challenge: Dispensable Marriages

- A. Cohabitation and out-of-wedlock childbearing are two of our fasting growing family configurations today.
- B. Marriage is no longer an assumed requirement for having a family.
- C. Since 1960, cohabitation has increased by 1000%.
- D. (Hebrews 13:4; 1 Corinthians 7:1-2).

II. Challenge: Disposable Marriages

- A. Many today have lost the ideal of marital permanence and "till death to us part."
- B. Divorce rates have skyrocketed in our generation.
- C. Two problems with failed marriages:
 - 1. Divorce (Matthew 19:6; 1 Corinthians 7:10-11).
 - 2. Adultery (Matthew 19:9).

III. Challenge: Definition of Marriage

- A. Our culture is entertaining a discussion that no other age or civilization has undertaken: i.e. to redefine marriage as a union between members of the same sex.
- B. However, marriage is not rooted in culture, but in the mind of God and is not to be trifled with without paying a price.
- C. (Genesis 2:24).

Conclusion: 1. If we, as God's children, don't embrace and proclaim God's truth on this important issue, our homes, and our society will suffer.

2. If God's institution is honored, man will be blessed; however if it is perverted, we will suffer at our own hands.
