# The Willing Disciple: Thomas

(John 26-29)

### **Introduction:**

- 1. Sometimes we associate people with what they do.
- 2. When it comes to Thomas, he is not known as Thomas the disciple, or Thomas the faithful, but rather "Doubting Thomas."
- 3. However, does Thomas really deserve that name?
- 4. After a closer examination of the text, we might decide that "Doubting Thomas," might be better dubbed, "Willing Thomas."

## I. Thomas Was Willing To Risk His Life

- A. (John 11:1-16).
- B. The disciples were reluctant to go with Jesus to Bethany.
- C. However, it was Thomas who was willing to die for Jesus and who encouraged boldness in the other disciples.
- D. You see, Thomas wasn't just a doubter, but was willing to die for the cause of Christ.
- E. There was something that Thomas has learned about Jesus through the past few years that would make him willing to forfeit his life in order to stand by his side.

## II. Thomas Was Willing To Ask Questions

- A. (John 14:1-6).
- B. Our perspective (2000 years after the fact) on the words of Jesus help to make clear for us, what must have been confusing to the first century disciples.
- C. Thomas didn't understand, so he asked an honest question.
- D. Jesus didn't rebuke or ridicule Thomas for his question.
- E. One of the biggest misconceptions that people sometimes have is that "questions are wrong."
- F. Questions are one of our greatest resources from growth, knowledge, and spiritual maturity.

## III. Thomas Was Willing To Accept The Truth

- A. (John 20:24-29).
- B. Note that Thomas wasn't the only disciple who had to see to believe this was not a peculiar characteristic of Thomas (Mark 16:11,14; Luke 24:11).
- C. Thomas wanted to be sure in the same way the other disciples wanted to be sure.
- D. However, note Thomas' reaction when presented with the truth.

#### **Conclusion:**

- 1. In the person of Thomas, I don't see a doubter above all others, I see a willing disciple.
- 2. We have recorded for us the response that Thomas gave with reference to the identity of Jesus, now it's our turn to make a decision.
- 3. Do you believe or doubt that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God?
