The Gospel of John: That You Might Believe "Responses to Jesus: The Woman at the Well" (John 4)

Introduction:

- 1. The book of John was written with the intent of proving the identity of Jesus.
- 2. On at least five separate occasions, people asked the question, "Who is this man?" (Mt. 21:10; Luke 5:21, 7:49; 9:9; John 5:12).
- 3. The Samaritan woman at the well is an excellent example.

I. The Events

- A. Jesus "needed to" go through Samaria (v. 4).
- B. The disciples go to get some food (v. 8)
- C. A Samaritan woman and a Jewish man talk (v. 9).
- D. She's convinced that He is the Messiah (v. 28).
- E. The disciples return and she gets the men of the city to see for themselves (v. 29-30).

II. The Offer

- A. "Salvation is of the Jews" (v. 22).
 - 1. Not exclusive rights to God.
 - 2. Messiah from the Jewish nation
- B. The new worship (v. 23-24).
 - 1. Nationality doesn't matter.
 - 2. Spirit and truth are what counts.
- C. Jesus offers her "living water" (v. 10).
 - 1. The physical vs. spiritual common problem
- B. Because Jesus is the Messiah, she needs to:
 - 1. ...give up sin (adultery).
 - 2. ...give up prideful traditions.
 - ...be so fully convinced that she will follow regardless of the cost.

III. The Difference

- A. The woman didn't argue, she obeyed.
- B. Because of His miraculous knowledge, she believed.
- C. She couldn't keep the message inside she did what the disciples should have done
 - 1. The disciples didn't see the harvest (v. 35).

IV. The Belief

- A. The men came to hear
- B. They believed because of Jesus' testimony (v. 41-42).
- C. Jesus stayed for two days (v. 43).

Conclusion:

- 1. You have the testimony in front of you today.
- 2. Will you...
 - a. Give up your sin?
 - b. Give up your prideful traditions?
 - c. Be so convinced that you'll follow regardless of the cost.
