What's A Father To Do?

I. A Father Must First Be A Good Husband

- A. One cannot be a good father without first being a good spouse.
- B. What we model before our children will help to shape their conduct.
- C. (Ephesians 5:25-33).
- D. Family relationships have much to do with our relationship with God (1 Peter 3:7).

II. A Father Must Be A Good Spiritual Leader

- A. (Ephesians 6:4).
- B. There are many things our children need to learn about life, but none are more important than learning about spiritual matters.
- C. A father's/husband's role of headship cannot simply be abdicated.
 - 1. Live it.
 - 2. Teach it.
 - 3. Be involved; participate.

III. A Father Must Be Patient

- A. (Ephesians 6:4; Colossians 3:21).
- B. Don't demand perfection one's *reaction* can be worse than the child's *infraction*.
- C. There is tremendous power in praise and conversely, a child can be destroyed by criticism.
- D. Make sure your children understand that the basis of your love for them is because of who they are and not on what they do.
