A THING OF BRASS (II Kings 18:4)

Introduction: 1. Christianity requires discernment (Hebrews 5:14).

- 2. Some things are more important than others (Matthew 23:23; John 19:11).
- 3. Jesus is on record telling us which commandment is the greatest of all (Matthew 22:37).
- 4. Though Jesus is clear on this point, many people in the past and present have failed to discern this truth.
- 5. Let's examine two Old Testament examples when people failed to discern and make some present day applications.

I. The Brazen Serpent

- A. (Numbers 21:4-9; II Kings 18;4).
- B. This "*thing of brass*" had become an idol to the Israelites.
- C. What was nothing more than a vehicle to enable people to know God better, became the people's god itself.

II. The Ark Of The Covenant

- A. (Exodus 25:10:22) Its description.
- B. (Deuteronomy 10:4-5) Its contents.
- C. Its significance.
 - 1. It was the place to know God's will (Exodus 25:22).
 - 2. It was the place of entreaty (Joshua 7:6-15).
 - 3. It was the place of atonement (Leviticus 16:2, 14-17).
- D. The ark however, became a *"good luck charm"*; their savior rather than God.
- E. (I Samuel 4:1-22).

III. Present Day Failures In Discernment

Conclusion: 1. Like the brazen serpent and the ark of the covenant, these modern day items just mentioned are not our savior.

- 2. They are means to an end and not an end in and of themselves.
- 3. When all is said and done, it won't matter if you study your Bible, how often you attend church, or whether you were baptized *if* you don't have a relationship with Christ.
- 4. *"You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind"* (Matthew 22:37).
