Introduction: 1. The church is often maligned today by people within and without.

- 2. However, Scripture presents a vastly different view of the church.
 - a. It is the fullness of Christ (Ephesians 1:22-23).
 - b. It is the manifold wisdom of God (Ephesians 3:10).
