Introduction:

- 1. One of the greatest compliments given to the church is listed in the above passage.
- 2. Not only is it a great compliment, but places upon us the most serious obligation.
- 3. We are the body of Christ in the world today. We are to be the point of contact Christ has with the world.
 - a. Our lips must speak the message of salvation as Jesus would have.
 - b. Our hands must bind up the wounds of sinners as Jesus would have.
 - c. Our feet must take us to people who need a Savior as Jesus would have.
- 4. If Jesus is living in His church, the church will reflect the attributes of Jesus.
- 5. The following are several attributes of Jesus the church ought to be reflecting.

I. The Church Should Be Prayerful

- A. Is prayer a notable characteristic of this congregation?
- B. (Matthew 21:13) My house shall be called a house of prayer.
- C. (Luke 11:1) Lord, teach us how to pray.
- D. Prayer is not an emotionless (Heb. 5:7 vehement cries), rote memorized, exercise in discipline.
- E. (Ephesians 3:20; James 5:16; 1 Thessalonians 5:17).

II. The Church Should Be Mission Minded

- A. (John 4:34) My food is to do the will of the Father.
- B. (Luke 19:10) I came to seek and save the lost.
- C. Ills. of the parable of the Lighthouse.
- D. (Philippians 1:21; Galatians 2:20).

III. The Church Should Be Compassionate & Merciful

- A. (Matthew 9:36) He was moved with compassion.
- B. (Matthew 23:23) Mercy is a weightier matter of the law.
- C. (Luke 23:34) Father, forgive them for they know not what they do.
- D. (Micah 7:18) Who is a God like you?...
- E. (Psalm 103:8-13).
- F. Ills. of kids and ambulance.

IV. The Church Should Teach As Jesus Taught

- A. (Matthew 7:28-29) They were astonished at his teaching.
- B. Characteristics of his teaching
 - 1. It was balanced (Matthew 5-7; 23).
 - 2. It was biblical as opposed to speculative (1 Peter 4:11; Luke 4).
 - 3. It was uncompromising (Mark 10:17-22).
