THE ENIGMA OF THE CROSS

(I Corinthians 1:18-31)

- Introduction: 1. An *enigma* is something that is hard to explain and hard to understand.
 - 2. Thus, the cross of Christ may aptly be called an enigma.
 - a. The Gentiles thought it was foolishness (1:23).
 - b. To the Jews it was a stumblingblock (1:23).
 - c. Today the cross has become a trinket, a beautiful piece of jewelry while its meaning is forgotten.
 - 3. Let us refocus our eyes on the cross of Jesus and perceive with clarity, the significance of this unparalleled event.

I. THE PARADOX OF THE CROSS

- A. One reason that the cross has been misunderstood is because it is a greaat paradox.
- B. Notice some of the paradoxes:
 - 1. It saddens us but it gives us joy.
 - 2. It was tragic but it was glorious.
 - 3. It was Satan's victory but it was also Satan's defeat.
 - 4. It brought shame to mankind but it also brought glory and honor.
 - 5. It shows God's hatred of sin but His love for the sinner.
 - 6. It brought death but it also brought life.
 - 7. On the cross, Jesus won by losing, and He overcame by surrendering.
- C. Although the cross of Christ appears to be full of contridictions, it is the means by which God chose to save us (I Corinthians 1:18).

II. THE PURPOSE OF THE CROSS

- A. Why did God send His Son, Jesus, to die on the cross?
- B. (Psalms 8:4) "What is man that You are mindful of him, and the son of man that You visit him?"
- C. There are two reasons that Jesus endured the cross.
 - 1. Theologically.
 - a. It was necessary for salvation atonement had to be made for our sins.
 - b. (II Corinthians 5:21; Romans 6:23).
 - 2. Personally.
 - a. God loves us dearly (John 3:16; Romans 5:6-8).
 - b. (Hebrews 12:1-2).
 - c. (Ephesians 2:16).

III. THE PLEDGE OF THE CROSS

- A. If our reconciliation to God was accomplished by Jesus on the cross, then is the work done (I Corinthians 1:29-31)?
- B. Although we are saved by the grace of God manifest on the cross, some may:
 - 1. Fall short of the grace of God (Hebrews 12:15).
 - 2. Receive the grace of God in vain (II Corinthians 6:1).
- C. "Jesus is the Answer", but He's not an easy fix.
- D. (Luke 14:25-28; Matthew 16:24-26).
