WHEN DUTIES BECOME DESIRES

(Hebrews 8:8-10)

Introduction: 1. The need exists for constant urging for people to perform their duties.

- 2. The reason: People's duties are not their desires.
- 3. When our duties become our desires, little urging will be necessary.
- 4. This lesson is designed to remind us of how important it is to mesh our duties with our desires.

I. God Wants His Law Written On Your Heart

- A. Throughout the Old Testament, God law remained written in stone rather than in the hearts of his people.
 - 1. (Matthew 15:8-9).
 - 2. (Matthew 23:23-24).
- B. Today, God demands that His law be written on our hearts.
- C. Our hearts need to be such that we desire to do what God wants us to do.

II. This Is The Way To A Happy And Fulfilling Life

- A. Someone has said that the way to happiness is to keep your wants few and simple.
- B. But there is a better way They way to happiness is to keep your desires within the bounds of your God given duties.
- C. Make a list of your duties needed to please God and then a list of your personal desires.
 - 1. This can probably serve as a pretty accurate gauge to measure one's happiness.

III. God's Will Was Christ's Desire

- A. Every desire that Christ had was in accordance with God's will.
- B. (John 8:28-29).
- C. (John 14:9).

IV. How Can My Duties Become My Desires

- A. First, realize that it is possible.
 - 1. Look at the life of Paul.
 - 2. (Philippians 3:4-9).
 - 3. (Galatians 2:20).
- B. Next, start practicing your duties (whether you want to or not).
- C. Read your Bible that you may know what your duties are.
- D. Pray for assistance (it's hard to rebel while you're praying Ps. 51:10).

Conclusion:

- 1. With determination and God's help, our duties can become our desires.
- 2. When that happens, we will find life so much more fulfilling and serving God will be so much more meaningful and joyful to us.
