I. Characteristics Of Strong Families Portrayed In Proverbs

- A. The Wife Must...
 - 1. Be trustworthy (Proverbs 31:11).
 - 2. Have an enduring love (Proverbs 31:12).
 - 3. Develop the inner person (Proverbs 31:25).
 - 4. Speak wisdom and kindness (Proverbs 31:26).
 - 5. Not be contentious (Proverbs 21:9,19).
- B. The Husband Must...
 - 1. Praise his wife (31:28-29).
 - 2. Be content with the wife of his youth (5:15-21).
- C. The Family Must...
 - 1. Guard their name and reputation (Proverbs 22:1).
 - 2. Be accountable to one another (Proverbs 12:15; 27:17).
 - 3. Practice forgiveness (Proverbs 17:9).
 - 4. Practice honesty (Proverbs 21:2-3).
 - 5. Practice reverence (Proverbs 14:26; 16:3).
 - 6. Practice contentment (Proverbs 15:16; 16:8).
 - 7. Practice respect (Proverbs 16:31; 23:22).
 - 8. Communicate (Proverbs 25:11).

Conclusion: 1. Proverbs advice for the home could be summarized by the following five points:

- a. Love one another and God.
- b. Administer disciple with loving concern.
- c. Practice consistency which provides security in standards and morals.
- d. Be the kind of example that instills deep faith in God.
- e. Be the kind of family that places God first in all of its decisions.
