- B. Every sincere Christian has probably struggled with the question of wealth and benevolence.

III. The Sin Of Idleness

- A. (Matthew 9:37-38) The call was not for a harvest, but for laborers.
- B. Would you characterize yourself as a worker in God's kingdom?
- C. (I Corinthians 15:58-59).
- D. (Matthew 20:1-16).

Conclusion:

- 1. While we previously would never have considered ourselves as being guilty of the sins of Sodom, maybe we need to take a closer look.
- 2. Don't allow sins that appear to us as obscure and possibly insignificant to rob us of our eternal reward.
