II. Are You Consumed With Zeal For The Doctrine Of Christ?

- A. (Mark 8:38) We cannot be ashamed of the doctrine of Christ.
- B. (1 Timothy 4:16) It is only by continuing in the doctrine of Christ that we can be saved.
- C. The doctrine of Christ is being challenged today.
 - 1. The worship of the church.
 - 2. The organization of the church.
 - 3. Moral standards of God's people.
- D. Let us demand more than a watered down gospel.
- E. Have you supported the doctrine of Christ, and those who proclaim it?
- F. Are you consumed with the doctrine of Christ?

III. Are You Consumed With Zeal For The Mission Of Christ?

- A. (Luke 19:10) Came to seek and save the lost.
- B. (Matthew 28:19-20) Make disciples of all nations.
- C. (Luke 14:16-24) Compel them to come in.
- D. Are you grieved by lost souls (Romans 9:2-3)?
- E. When is the last time you prayed for a lost soul?
- F. Are you consumed with the mission of Christ?

Conclusion: 1. Lest you think zeal was appropriate in the life of Jesus but not in our own life, remember the words of Jesus in Matthew 22:36-38.
